

— World Junior Championships Men —

Moncton, New Brunswick—Conor McCullough of Princeton had the pedigree and the premeet form to be confident coming into the World Junior Championships, boasting a silver medal in '08 and some American Junior Record efforts earlier this year, but his road to the gold was far from smooth in the Maritimes.

Never mind the wait of more than a week in Canada to compete, McCullough had more pressing issues when his father suffered pulls of both quadriceps muscles in a midweek fall and had to be flown back to California for emergency surgery.

None of that seemed to bother the heir apparent to AR holder Lance Deal, though, as he trailed only once in the final and crushed his own AJR—and the meet record—with his second-round 265-0 (80.79).

A series that featured two other 80-plus throws (see p. 247) cemented his win over favored Ákos Hudi of Hungary and capped a sterling Junior career.

"I wanted to put pressure on right away," McCullough said. "The ring was great, my technique was good, and the atmosphere was fantastic."

Overall, McCullough produced U.S. all-time Junior performances of 1, 2, 3, 6, 8 in moving to No. 6 on the all-time world Junior list.

Team USA was perfect in relay action, sweeping the events in convincing fashion. Collegians Michael Granger, 100 silver medalist Charles Silmon and Eric Harris teamed

A bronze medalist in the 400, Houston's Errol Nolan keyed the 4x4 win with a 45.4 second leg on a barely-challenged 3:04.86 relay bookended by preps Joshua Mance and Michael Berry, with David Verburg of George Mason on the third carry.

Looking to score the first U.S. medals ever in the 800, college rivals Cas Loxsom (1:46.57 PR) of Penn State and Robby Andrews (1:47.00) of Virginia made history with their 2-3 finish, perhaps showing that the recent renaissance in American middle and long distance running is far from shallow.

Ranked outside the medal hopes coming in, Georgia high schooler David Smith was a surprise silver medalist in the high jump with a prep-leading 7-4¼ (2.24) clearance, and Florida frosh Omar Craddock battled strong headwinds to triple jump 53-3 (16.23) and earn bronze.

The best hope to revitalize U.S. walking fortunes, '09 World Youth 4th-placer Trevor Barron shattered his own AJR in the 10K event, lopping more than 30 seconds off with a 41:50.29 for 7th.

Russia's Valeriy Filipchuk won at 40:43.17.

Javelin throwers loved the conditions, with Germany's Till Wöschler moving to =No. 4 all-time with his 270-9 (82.52), with Washington's Joe Zimmerman earning silver with a 244-10 (74.64) that rated as the No. 2 U.S. Junior
