

### — World Junior Championships Women —

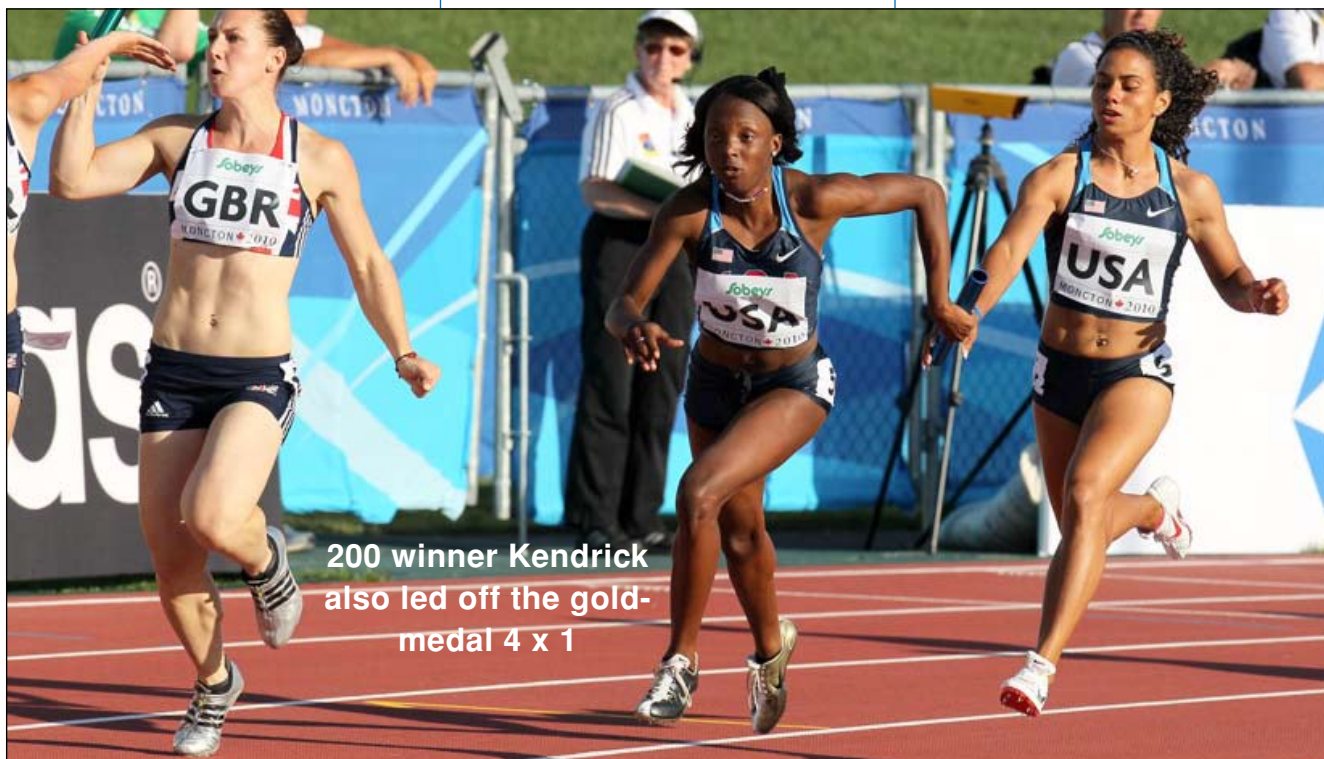
Moncton, New Brunswick—Clemson's Stormy Kendrick wasn't exactly an unknown coming into the World Junior Championships, but to call her win over British wunderkind Jodie Williams in the 200 an upset would be more than an understatement.

Kendrick did in Canada what no one in

With the spell broken, Kendrick assisted in picking up the second victory of the Championships the following day with a superb lead leg on the U.S. 4x1 that clocked 43.44, the No. 6 Junior time ever. LSU's Takeia Pinckney, the 100 silver medalist, blew open the race on the second leg, and preps Dezerea Bryant and Ashley Collier carried it home.

"I went along for the ride with a fast pack," she said. "I didn't feel too exhausted after the 3K, and I am so glad I ran this. I didn't even know what the national record was, and I am so excited to break it at this big meet."

A spot ahead of Sisson's 10<sup>th</sup> in the 3000 was Jordan Hasay, PRing at 9:15.78. Hasay came back to take 4<sup>th</sup> in the 1500 at 4:13.95,



200 winner Kendrick also led off the gold-medal 4 x 1

more than 150 races had been able to do—beat Williams—and her gold kick-started a U.S. team which to that point had been disappointingly average.

Zippering to a 22.99 PR that beat Williams by 0.20, Kendrick also notched the first major win of her career and dismantled the wall of invincibility that had surrounded the closely-protected Britton, winner of the 100 in 11.40.

"I was feeling very good and I came here to win," Kendrick said. "There was great competition, but I kept my focus on me."

U.S. Gold No. 3 came in the penultimate event as Regina George of Arkansas anchored the 4x4 to victory in 3:31.20 with a 52.2.

After a shaky opener by Diamond Dixon, Stacey-Ann Smith put the Americans in position with her 52.2 second leg, before half-miler Laura Roesler, a surprising pick for the team, took control of the race with a 52.3 carry.

Running the 5000 as an afterthought to the 3000, where she had PRed at 9:16.80, Emily Sisson rolled to a High School Record 15:48.91 in 6<sup>th</sup>.

the No. 8 U.S. Junior time ever.

Big 10 athletes won the other two medals for Team USA with Michigan's Erin Pendleton (180-4/54.96) taking silver in the discus and Penn State's Evonne Britton (57.32) bronze in the 400 hurdles. Britton also took 6<sup>th</sup> in the straightaway barriers at 13.50.

Agee Wilson's PR 2:04.18 for 5<sup>th</sup> in the 800 bettered her own national yearly high school lead.

Edition No. 14 of the World Junior Championships will be held in Barcelona in 2012.
