

— 20th European Championships —

Barcelona, Spain; July 27–August 1—Although triple-gold-winning French sprinter Christophe Lemaître stole most of the headlines, the standout performances at the 20th European Championships came from German long jumper Christian Reif, British triple jumper Phillipps Idowu and Russia's 400H convert Natalya Antyukh.

Reif leapt out to a world-leading 27-9½ (8.47) with his third jump to give Dwight Phillips something to think about for the rest of the summer and relegate Robert Emmyan's '86 meet record of 27-7 (8.41) to history.

The 25-year-old German advertised that he was a gold medal contender and ready to produce a big distance by equalling his PR, 27-1¾ (8.27), in qualifying.

Also jumping 27-1¾ in the Q-round was Spain's 18-year-old Eusebio Cáceres, who set a European Junior Record and became the No. 3 Junior in history. The teenager couldn't quite live up to local expectations in the final, however, and finished 8th.

Said Reif, "As I am one of Europe's best jumpers my aim was to gain a medal. After confirming my ability in the qualification, I knew that I could do well in the final. Then I had two poor jumps at the beginning and I

had to pull it back in the third. That was my golden jump."

Another 24-year-old MR was erased when Antyukh sped around one lap over the barrier

cause of the time and going under 53 seconds but because Mariya is not just a name in the history books," said Antyukh. "She and her husband are close friends and we talk several times a week. However, I still didn't have any idea that I was going to be that quick between the hurdles," reflected Antyukh.

At 29, Antyukh is not quite the hurdles novice that she has been portrayed as in some reports. In fact, she was primarily a hurdler in her Junior days but concentrated on the flat 400 in the last decade—in which her achievements include a 2004 OG bronze—before switching back last year after 8 years away from the event.

Reigning world champ Idowu has had an erratic season and won only three of his contests before coming to Catalonia. However, just as he proved in Berlin, he is often the man for the big occasions.

He bounded out to a PR of 58-5½ (17.81) in the fourth round and had three other jumps over 57-1 (17.40). "It doesn't matter how many you lose beforehand as long as you can get it right when it

counts," said the 31-year-old Londoner.

Romania's Marian Oprea stunned himself and pundits when he got the silver with a fifth-round 57-5½ (17.51), his longest jump since '06, which sent France's world leader Teddy Tamgho down to 3rd at 57-3 (17.45).

However, one French favorite that did live up to his billing was the 20-year-old Lemaître

ers in a Russian Record 52.92, a time which has only been beaten by Lashinda Demus this year (and only 11 others ever).

The previous owner of both marks, although they were set in separate competitions, was Mariya Stepanova, whose best of 52.94 was a WR when she ran it in '86.

"For me, this is a huge feat, not just be-

tre, who became the first man to win gold in the 100, 200 and 4x1.

Even though his individual times of 10.11 and 20.37 were relatively modes—owing to the fact that he was running into a stiff breeze—the sheer raw power he exhibited impressed everyone.

In total, seven championships records were broken. In addition to the Reif and Antyukh, the pick of the rest of them would have to be the world-leading heptathlon tally of 6823 by Britain's Jessica Ennis, who got a PR in the javelin and ran very close to her best in the 200 and 800 to hold off the Ukraine's Olympic gold medalist Natalya Dobrynska.

The athletes did their work in front of almost full houses of 40,000 for the last four days of the Championships. To ensure that the event looked good on TV, upper-tier sections of the normally 55,000 capacity Montjuïc Stadium that was the centerpiece of the '92 Olympics were closed.

Poor attendances on the first two days lead to some worried faces among the local organizers, especially as the bad state of the Spanish economy and the start of the local holiday season had lead to some fears that attendances would be hit.

But the appearance of local heroine and Berlin gold medalist Marta Domínguez on Thursday, who lost out to Russia's Yuliya Zarudneva in the race for the women's steeple title, seemed to be the catalyst for the public to come on out.
