

— Rudisha Takes Down Kipketer's 800 WR —

Berlin, Germany—With a father who won Olympic silver in the 4x4, David Rudisha became tabbed as a potential World Record setter in the 800 when he joined the 1:44 club as an 18-year-old in '07.

Keeping the progression in perfect order, he joined the 1:43s at 19, the 1:42s at 20 and the 1:41s at 21 back in July in Heusden-Zolder.

"The World Record is now my next target," he said after his 1:41.51 Dutch exploit made him history's No. 2, tantalizingly close to Wilson Kipketer's 13-year-old WR of 1:41.11. "First I wanted to run 1:41-something, but I've now made that step and I'm going to start thinking about the World Record."

He and manager James Templeton planned the campaign out well: after Heusden he returned to Nairobi for a couple of weeks of training then an easy African Championships win.

Then it was another three weeks training, ignoring the Diamond League and pointing for a big one at the ISTAF affair.

The big one was hooked, as a spectacular 1:41.09 relegated Kipketer to the history books.

Sammy Tangui was enlisted as the pacemaker and he covered the first 200 in 24-flat, with Rudisha 0.2 behind. At the halfway point, the field was already far behind as Tangui split 48.65 and Rudisha followed at 49.1.

Kipketer had split 49.3 in his WR, so the record-attempt was on in serious fashion. Tangui got out of the way and Rudisha continued

on. His third 200 was his slowest yet, 25.4, but he reached the 600 in 1:14.54, a virtual dead head with Kipketer's 1:14.6. Kipketer had finished in 26.5; what could Rudisha do?

Just about the same: a 26.55 that gave him the all-time best by just 0.02.

"Last year I had a bad time in Berlin," said the happy winner, remembering his failure to make the World Champs final. "So I did not want to talk too much about the World record before today's race."

Now the debate begins on whether or not Rudisha will be Athlete Of The Year. He still plans to run the DL final in Brussels, in Rieti (traditionally a *very* fast site for 800s) and at the Continental Cup.

Behind Rudisha, U.S. miler Leo Manzano showed a new turn of speed, joining the sub-1:45 club as he finished 4th in a PR 1:44.56.

Tariku Bekele captured the 3000 in a world-leading 7:28.99.

Rudisha's 200s got steadily slower—24.2, 24.9, 25.4, 26.55—but it didn't matter
