

— Mekonnen Tops Lagat At Millrose —

New York City, January 28—Have the years finally caught up to Bernard Lagat? Or was there simply no catching Deresse Mekonnen?

That was the great debate as 9611 Madison Square Garden-goers filed to the exits after a drama-packed 104th Millrose Games.

L a g a t marked his 36th birthday on Dec. 12. Mekonnen won't be 24 until October 24.

Was Mekonnen's 3:58.58–3:59.01 triumph in the classic Wanamaker Mile, on the venerable 11-laps-to-the-mile Garden saucer, a rite of passage? Or simply an early-season aberration?

Post-race discussion swung in all directions. But the bottom-line verdict, as fans

told each other on the way home, was “only time will tell.”

This time, it wasn't Lagat's race to win. The three-time Olympian flew into New York from his Tucson home base riding a 6-race Wanamaker winning streak, and aiming to extend his overall Wanamaker win total to an astounding 9.

Such was the intensity of his bid for another Wanamaker that he violated the cardinal rule of big-time indoor-mile winning, first

second best.

Sure, it's very-very early in a season that won't peak until late August at Daegu's World Championships, and neither man had raced seriously in months, but it could easily prove a harbinger of things to come.

“I'm going against a great athlete who is very smart and a very good indoor racer,” Lagat acknowledged. “So in order for me to win I would have had to run like I've never

enunciated by Eamonn Coghlan: “one move and one move only,” three fruitless times,

But each blast was destined for frustration. Mekonnen, who'd seized the lead approaching the final three laps, was simply not ready to be taken.

T h e younger man, born in Sheno, in Ethiopia's Oromia region, already twice a world indoor champion, simply had too much in his tank. The race still went down to the final strides before Lagat's get-up-and-go finally proved

run before.”

He simply couldn't do it.

“I didn't think I'd run this well,” said Mekonnen, the roundly-applauded new main man of The Big Apple's astute clock-watchers. “I thought I would make maybe 4th or 5th,” he downplayed.

Ever the sportsman, Mekonnen added: “I expected Lagat to win. He's a great guy. I would have been happy if he had won, too.”

Cal grad David Torrence nabbed 3rd in 4:00.13, relegating Brit Lee Emanuel, the two-time NCAA king for New Mexico, to 4th in 4:04.91.

Villanova Irishman Coghlan had won the Wanamaker 7 times. Glenn Cunningham won 6 of them and Marcus O'Sullivan 5, while 4 apiece went to Don Gehrman and Ronnie Delany.

But no Wanamaker Miler had ever been as dominant as Lagat, whose wins came in 3:58.26 ('01), 4:00.26 ('03), the meet-record 3:52.87 ('05), 3:56.85 ('06), 3:54.26 ('07), 3:57.51 ('08), 3:58.44 ('09) and 3:56.34 ('10). In his only prior Millrose loss, he was nosed out by Laban Rotich, 3:57.04–3:57.38, in '03. He then sat out '04 before embarking on his 6-meet winning streak.

Will Lagat win again at Millrose? Can he stay in sub-4:00 shape into his 40s, as Coghlan did? Will he shift focus to, likely, his better event, the 5000 meters? Who knows? But stay tuned, track fans.

There were other changing-of-the-guard moments at Millrose, too, authored by Fabiana Murer, Ashton Eaton and Ryan Whiting.

Murer, the world No. 1, soared to 15-6½

(4.74) on second attempt, in her Garden debut, leaving behind U.S. champion Jenn Suhr after three misses at 15-2¾ (4.64). The event won, Murer gave a 15-10½ (4.84) a good test before calling it a night.

“The crowd was helping me to jump,” said the Brazilian star. “The Millrose Games, of course, it is a nice competition.”

Eaton came in as the young guy behind the bemedaled vets in the Millrose “multi-challenge” 3-eventer—a great idea giving the multi-men a rare crack at big-meet prime time—and went out a very happy winner.

After settling for fourth (of five entries) in the shot (46-8/14.22 PR), Eaton came roaring back to win it all with a win in the 60 hurdles (PR 7.64) and co-lead in the high jump at 6-8¾ (2.05) with Duke soph flash Curtis Beach.

It added up this way: Eaton 2666; Trey Hardee 2640; Bryan Clay 2609; Jake Arnold 2491, Beach 2360.

“When I had to clear a height in the high jump to win, that's what I did,” said the happy ex-Duck. “This is my fifth year with the multis. You just grow over time and there's a lot of learning that gets done.”

Next stop for Oregon grad Eaton: Tallinn, Estonia, this weekend for a shot at his own world heptathlon record.

Whiting, the Arizona State grad from Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, outmuscled world gold medalists Christian Cantwell (69-4¼/21.14) and Reese Hoffa (67-4/20.52), as two-time Olympic silver medalist Adam Nelson fouled all four.

Form held in the women's 60: two-time Olympic 200-meter queen Veronica Campbell (7.11) easily outclassing Lauryn Williams (7.22) and Lisa Barber (7.23.)

Before any of this at the Garden, the weight throwers went at it at The Armory, 135 blocks to the Garden's north, with the winners almost exactly matching distances.

Amber Campbell muscled the women's 20-pounder 79-1 (24.16) and Jake Freeman sent the men's 35 on a ride of 79-3 (24.10) as each won by more than 10 feet.
