

### — 2 HSRs For Crouser At Simplot —

Pocatello, Idaho, February 19—When shot putter Ryan Crouser (Barlow, Gresham, Oregon) stepped into the ring for his first throw there was already a buzz in the crowd in an anticipation of what was about to come at the 33<sup>rd</sup> Simplot Indoor Games.

In his first season of indoor competition, his first two meets produced throws of 73-1 and 74-5 to move into No. 2 on the all-time list behind national record holder Brent Noon (Fallbrook, California), who had thrown 74-11 in 1990.

And for good measure he upped the High School Record with the international shot to 63-11.

At Simplot, Crouser opened with a “conservative” 72-1½ to break the meet record of 67-10½ set by Noon in '90.

But when Crouser's second-round throw left his hand and began to arc out over the landing area it was obviously going to go a long way as the crowd erupted with a loud applause.

Their faith was rewarded with an initially announced measurement of 75-1 that was then confirmed at a record-breaking 75-3½.

Crouser then fouled his final throw of the prelims with a mark judged to have been close to his previous throw, and did the same on his first throw in the final.

Stepping into the

ring for his fifth attempt the entire arena crowd was riveted on shot. After the ball left his hand it was again obvious that it was going to at least as far as his new record. It was just a question of could he stay in the ring and how far the throw would be.

When no red flag appeared the first ques-

tion was answered and the announcement of 77-2¾ followed by the crowd's roar answered the second question. It was another national record and the No. 2 throw of all-time—indoors or out.

A final throw of 75-11½ was almost anticlimactic despite being the second-best indoor throw ever.

Crouser will now turn his attention to the outdoor season, where his first major competition is likely to be the Arcadia Invitational in April.

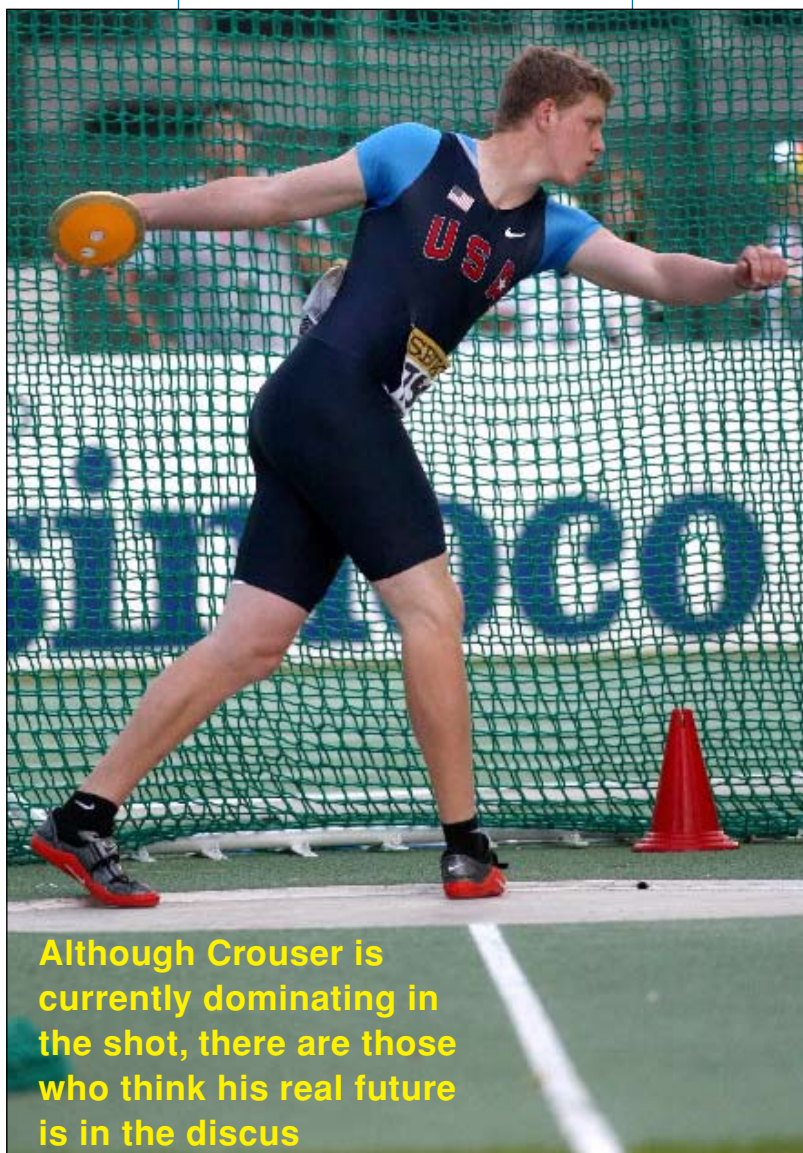
This is also the time that Crouser, as the old saying goes, “will begin to dream the impossible dream.”

It has been more than 30 years since Michael Carter (Jefferson, Dallas) set the national outdoor record of 81-3½ at the '79 Golden West Invitational—on the final throw of his high school career.

That incomprehensible throw left Carter almost 10 feet better than No. 2 on the all-time list, and in the years since then the farthest anyone had ever thrown was Noon's 76-2 in '90.

Carter's mark is widely considered the greatest high school mark ever and for the first time in almost two decades there is at least the thought that it might be broken.

There were a number of other outstanding marks at the biggest indoor meet west of the Mississippi, as 1357 meters of altitude was

friendly to sprinters and jumpers.

National leader and defending champion Trinity Wilson (St. Mary's, Berkeley) won the 60 hurdles in 8.28 for the No. 6 performance of all time.

Ciarra Brewer (Logan, Union City, California), who lost most of her junior year to injury, won the triple jump at 42-3½ to move into No. 8 on the all-time list.

Shelby Ashe (Pius X, Atlanta) keeps inching closer to her national weight record of 65-4¾ she set last year—winning at 64-9¾ as well as throwing 64-1¼. She now has the eighth farthest throws of all time.

Kyle Price (Amat, La Puente, California) and Darian Brooks (Kennedy, Burien, Washington) were both double winners.

Price won the girls' long jump in the morning at 19-6 but only after taking a "safety" jump of 17-8 ½ prior to fouling her first two attempts. Next up was the 60 where she scored a minor upset running 7.47 to rank No. 2 in the nation.

Hannah Cunliffe (Decatur, Federal Way, Washington) was 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7.47 to break the national frosh-class record of 7.49.

Brooks also won the 60, edging soph Marcus Harris (Eaglecrest, Centennial, Colorado) 6.85-6.88. He then won the triple jump at 47-11.
