

— USATF Indoor Championships —

Albuquerque, New Mexico, February 26–27—With no World Indoor Championships to shoot for, and the outdoor Worlds not coming until the end of August, a lot of the nation’s biggest stars gave a pass on the ’11 indoor season.

And others did compete, but decided to forego competing in the USATF Indoor Championships.

The near-capacity crowds who filled Albuquerque’s Convention Center on the last weekend of February were nonetheless treated to two entertaining days of competition, particularly on the women’s side, which produce a pair of national records.

With 4960-foot (1512m) of altitude, marks were predictably good in the sprints and jumps and predictably hampered in the distances.

Men: Visa Title And \$25K To Rodgers

Organizers couldn’t have written a better script in the race for the Visa Championship Series and its grand prize of \$25,000.

Shot putter Ryan Whiting led the series (based on IAAF scoring-table points) coming in, and increased his lead late in the meet with the year’s first 70-foot throw.

But in the meet’s final event, with Whiting staged at the finish line of the 60 holding a stopwatch, Mike Rodgers turned in a world-leader of his own, a PR 6.48 that gave him the big prize.

“That was probably the easiest race I ever had,” he said. “I just didn’t have a start, because of the false start. I sat and the guy held us even longer for the second gun.”

USATF Women: ARs For Suhr & Camarena-Williams

AMERICAN RECORDS highlighted the women's side of the USATF Indoor. The first came in the shot, when Jill Camarena-Williams—in addition to winning her seventh straight crown—brought Ramona Pagel's long reign to an end.

Pagel threw 65-¾ (19.83) back in '87, but Stanford grad Camarena-Williams took care of that with a 65-2 ¼ (19.87) on her

third attempt. "I knew a big throw was coming but I didn't know how far," Camarena-Williams said.

At first, it appeared that she hadn't broken the record, merely tied it, but when the official metal-tape reading was taken, she had sole position of the new standard.

Jenn Suhr also got a second (no, make that fourth) chance at an AR. With the event

already won at 15-7 (4.75), she needed an AR 15-10½ (4.84) to take over the Visa lead, but she and husband Rick opted instead to slice the bologna thick and had the crosspiece set at 15-11¼ (4.86).

After three decent attempts that failed, it appeared she was done for the day, but her protest regards the setting of the standards on the final attempt was successful and she got chance No. 4.

"You'll always take another jump when you can," she said.

And No. 4 was the charm as she slid over nicely to claim the non-Isinbaeva World Record.

She then failed in three attempts at 16-2 (4.93) and said, "It's exciting. The best is just to keep coming out healthy and keep jumping."

Jenny Simpson, who quipped, "Barringer is just my alias," vied with the two AR setters as the week-end's most popular athlete, scoring only the fourth distance double in meet history.

Simpson ran 4:34.96 and 9:02.20 to put an exclamation point on a return from a disappointing first pro season lost to injury.

"Take that everyone who thought I wasn't going to be back," she said.

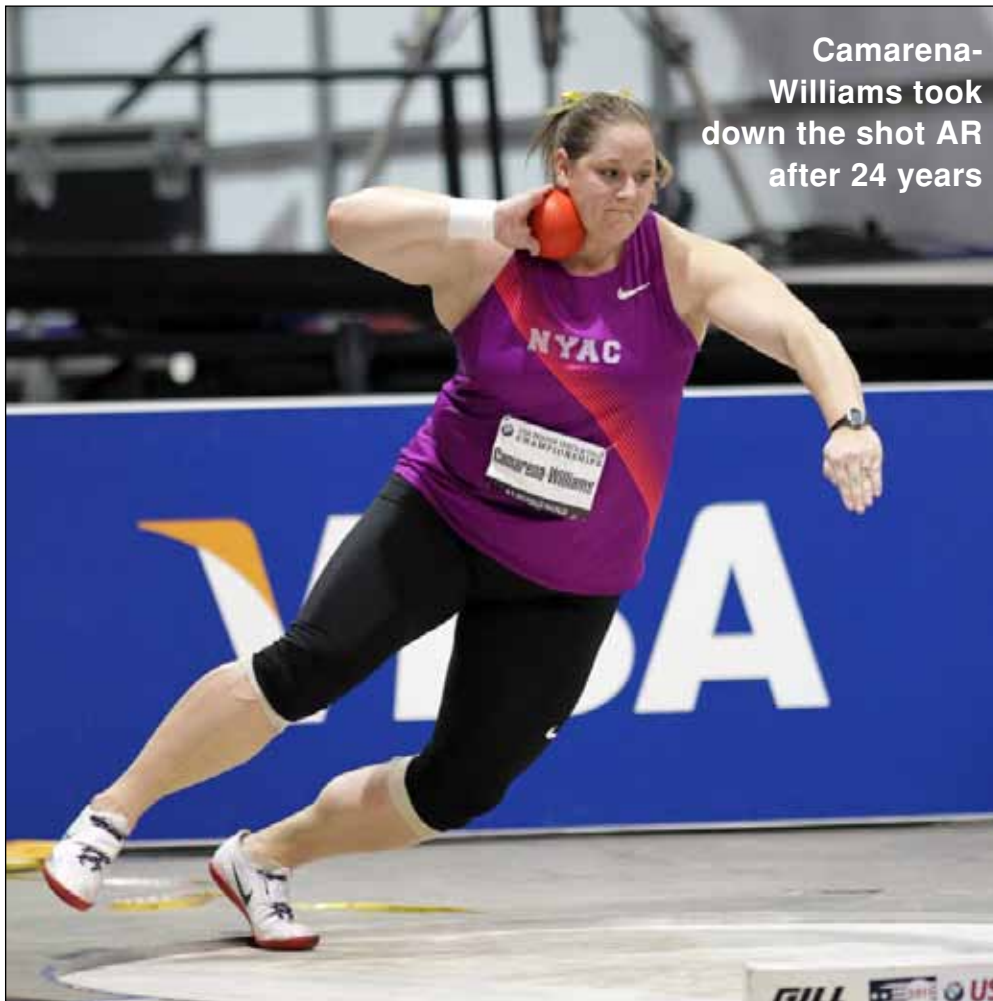
