

— European Indoor Championships —

Paris, France, March 4–6—Teddy Tamgho got his second indoor triple jump World Record of the winter (and the third of his career), and then for good measure equaled it when he bounded out to 58-9½

one-man show as the friendly runway provided the best-ever indoor-marks-for-place for positions 1, 2 & 3.

Romania's Marian Oprea opened with 57-9¼ (17.62) which Tamgho, jumping three later in the rotation, could only re-

Russia topped the medal table once again with 15 medals—including 6 golds—although their haul was down from the 10 victories they got in Torino two years ago.

However, it was the host nation's athletes who stole the headlines and not just because they were on home territory.

Renaud Lavillenie went over a 19-9¼ (6.03) NR in the vault at the first time of asking before having the bar audaciously raised to a WR 20-2¼ (6.16) WR.

He wasn't close on this occasion but he showed that the 20-foot club, which still has the exclusive membership of just Sergey Bubka (who was in attendance), may be opening its books in the near future.

Leslie Djhone was the class act in the men's 400 and ran a 45.54 NR over two laps of the track before following it up with a blistering sec-

ond leg which was crucial in France taking the 4x4 title, the very last of the 26 events to provide a fitting end to the championship, with anchor man Yoan Décimus crossing the line in an NR of 3:06.17.

Russian high jumper Ivan Ukhov ended his indoor season unbeaten and equaled his WL by going over 7-9¼ (2.38) for the third time this winter.

Three men went over 7-8 (2.34) but only Ukhov could master anything higher, going over 7-8¼ (2.36) and then 7-9¾, with his

Spurred on by the prospect of having his family and friends among the 8000 capacity crowd at the Palais Omnisport Paris-Bercy arena, the flying Frenchman had bravely promised a WR in the weeks before leading up to the championship and while he didn't hit his target of becoming the first 18-meter man under cover, there was no sense of disappointment after what was far from a

spond to with 57-2 (17.42). In the second round, the fireworks continued when Italy's defending champion Fabrizio Donato bounded out to a 58-1 NR (17.70) before Tamgho produced the first of his record leaps.

However, despite going into the history books, Tamgho couldn't completely relax.

Donato improved further to 58-2 (17.73) in the fourth round, moving him up to =8th on the all-time list, before Tamgho equaled his earlier mark.

first attempt at both heights, before taking a tilt again at the WR of 8-0 (2.44) again, just like he had done in Hustopeče and Banská Bystrica where he had also jumped 7-9¼.

The pick of the women's events also came in the field with Poland's '09 outdoor vault world champ Anna Rogowska going over 15-11 (4.85) before failing at 16-1¼ (4.91) to go =No. 3 on the all-time indoor rankings

There was also an Italian double triumph in the women's jumps with Simona La Mantia surprisingly taking the triple jump title with 47-10¼ (14.60).

Like her male counterpart Tamgho, she reached the distance twice in the competition, in the second and fifth rounds and for good measure her third-round 47-6¼ (14.49) would have also won her the gold medal.

Less of a shock was La Mantia's compatriot Antonietta Di Martino taking the high jump gold medal. There were three women still in the competition at 6-6¼ (1.99) but Di Martino was the only one to go clear, and with her first attempt.

With the competition won she also went

over 6-7 (2.01).

The track events overall paled slightly by comparison to the field but British runners won both the 3000 races with an impressive turn of speed over the final furlong.

Mo Farah, who had his bags packed to fly from Paris and start a new life in Oregon under the guidance of Alberto Salazar, showed a Beleke-esque turn of speed to hold off Azerbaijan's Ethiopian-born Hayle Ibrahimov and stop the clock in 7:53:00, although the latter did get his country's first ever medal at the Championships.

Helen Clitheroe, who turned 37 in January, became the second oldest woman to win a gold medal at the Championships after just edging out Russia's Olesya Syreva by 0.03, crossing the line in 8:56.66.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.
