

### — NCAA Men's Indoor Champs —

College Station, Texas, March 11–12—Florida looked impressive as it repeated as NCAA men's team champion, only the fourth team in NCAA history to do so.

The Gators scored in every event they were supposed to, and the only damage the team suffered was when 400 threat Tony McQuay tweaked his hamstring during his qualifying race. He made it to the final where he placed 7<sup>th</sup>, but aside from McQuay, Mike Holloway's Gators were firing on all cylinders.

On the track, the meet got off to a rollicking start Friday evening when Iona's Leonard Korir sprinted away from Liberty's Sam Chelanga and Arizona's Stephen Sambu to win the 5000 in 13:26.01.

That race set the stage for the distance medley. After a very competitive first three legs, BYU's Miles Batty was giving the lead for the 1600 leg. His 3:56.14 was just enough to hold off a charging Andrew Bayer (3:53.29) of Indiana and Ben Blankenship (3:54.61) of Minnesota. BYU's final time of 9:29.28 was 0.37 ahead of Indiana and 0.42 ahead of Minnesota.

In all, the anchors for the top 7 teams produced splits under 4:00, with the times for Bayer and Blankenship being the two fastest in meet history.

Saturday's running started off with a bang as Batty toed the line in the mile. You had to wonder if the Cougar had bit off more than he could chew after competing in the DMR the night before in addition to his mile qualifying race, where he ran 4:00.87. In the end, there was no wonder, as Batty used a slow pace to his advantage and out-kicked Tulsa's Chris O'Hare and Penn State's Ryan Foster. Batty's 3:59.49 was 0.13 faster than O'Hare, but it was his 27.36 closing circuit that was the decider as he ran down the stretch.

Jeff Demps proved once again that he is the fastest man around with an eye opening 6.53 PR in the 60. Demps got a sensational start and was challenged to the finish by Michael Granger (6.55) of Mississippi as he powered to the line. Pre-race cofavorite Mookie Salaam was a non-factor in the final, as he may have been a bit jaded after winning the 200 the night before in a world-leading 20.41.

The 400 was primed to be one of the premier events of the championships and before the final, Alabama's Kirani James was quoted saying, "For me to win, I must go out and get to the post first. That way, I have a chance to control the race."

The first section of the final was won by Texas A&M's Demetrius Pinder in 45.33, with defending champion Torrin Lawrence next in 45.96. In section 2, it was evident that James was determined to get to the break first, as was Texas A&M's Tabarie Henry. Coming off turn 2, Henry had a slight lead, but James and his long strides succeeded in getting in front of Henry before the bell.

But it was still a bit too close. As he started to cut into lane 1,

James' heel was clipped by Henry. James went down a step later and the race went on without him. Henry went on to win the section, but his time of 46.44 was only good enough for 4th place overall.

On the field, Florida's jumpers garnered significant points. After finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> in the long jump to Florida State's Ngoni Maku-sha, Will Claye came through on his final jump to overtake 2-time defending champion teammate Christian Taylor in the triple jump. A third Gator, Omar Craddock, finished 5<sup>th</sup>, giving the Gators a total of 22 points.

Other highlights included Indiana's Derek Drouin's winning the men's high jump in 7-73/4, equaling the Canadian Record and Illinois' Andrew Riley upsetting LSU's Barrett Nugent in the 60H, 7.58-7.61.

### What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate (“agate” is journalese for small-type results), so let’s see if we can’t clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as “9, x W” would mean that the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like “x, 6A”. The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL) and High School (HS).
