

— Arcadia: HSR For Nixon In Dec —

Arcadia, California, April 7-9—Some years at the Arcadia Invitational, the distance events are showcased; other years highlight the sprints and every now and then a field event steals the show. Well, that was just the case as there was a potpourri of outstanding marks in the 44th edition of the fabled high school meet.

It is not unusual for the meet to start out with a bang from its Friday Night Relays.

But this year the relays had to share the spotlight with decathlon star Gunnar Nixon (Santa Fe, Edmond, Oklahoma), whose international implements score of 7524, broke Curtis Beach's 2009 High School Record by 62 points.

Unfortunately, Nixon, still just a junior, missed out on an even greater score, and perhaps a high-school implements record as well. The former was because of a wind-aided long jump and the second—3 fouls in the shot—left Beach's 7909 safe.

Nixon's big-boy-implements marks: 11.06, 24-1 $\frac{3}{4}$ w (7.36w)/23-5 $\frac{1}{4}$ (7.14), 39-10 (12.14), 6-7 $\frac{1}{2}$ (2.02), 48.37, 14.60, 116-1 (35.38), 14-5 $\frac{1}{4}$ (4.40), 170-7 (52.00), 4:39.64

He also ran the prep hurdles (14.35) and threw the prep discus (123-0/37.49).

On Saturday, the meet really got roll-

ing when two California seniors, Jantzen Oshier (Trabuco Hills) and Matt Carpowich (Torrey Pines) had a terrific duel in the mile. In the end, it was Oshier outspringing Carpowich to the finish 4:06.81-4:07.15 to take the early season national outdoor lead.

Next up was the boys' 110 hurdles,

where Agoura's defending champion Jonathan Cabral not only destroyed the field, but posted a nation's best/meet record of 13.43. The Oregon-bound senior didn't rest too long on his laurels as he returned a couple hours later to post a personal best in a nation leading 36.42 in the long hurdles.

An elated Cabral, who has been working with his dad on the mechanics of hurdling this year, said, "I was really looking to set a personal best in both events, and I did it."

Academy's Julia Foster (10:19.79), Glacier Peak, Washington's Amy-Eloise Neale (10:20.84) and defending California state champion Molly Grabill of Ranch Bernardo (10:22.71).

"I didn't think I would go that fast, but I pushed the pace early and focused on getting out of that big group" Baxter said. It was the second victory for Baxter at Arcadia, as she anchored Simi Valley's 4 x 1600 relay Friday night with an impressive 4:53 split.

At last year's meet, Remontay McClain (Covina, CA) didn't even garnish an invitation to the men's invitational 100m race. Since that time, he's become the California

state 100m champion after running 10.34 to defeat favored George Farmer of Gardena Serra.

So, when the gun went off Saturday night, nobody was really sure who would top whom. It appeared that McClain had a step on the USC-bound Farmer, but the Serra senior composed himself and ran down McClain and Rancho Bernardo's Jared Pickering to win by 0.02, 10.62-10.64.

The always anticipated boys' 3200 was won by Arcadia's own Ammar Moussa, who separated himself from the pack with 600m left, and hung on to win in an impressive 8:49.59, ahead of Matthew Jablonski (Loyola, Blakefield, MD) 8:50.80 and Carmel Indiana's Chris Walden 8:51.59.

In total, 10 athletes snuck under the magical 9:00 barrier (and 7 did it converting the times to 2 Miles).

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is jounalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.
