

— The 117th Penn Relays —

Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, April 26–30—No Usain Bolt this year? No matter.

Sure, there were no Lightning Bolts (other than the real kind, which sent the late Thursday program into huge delay) at the Penn Relays this year, but the 117th edition of the classic Carnival still gave the huge Franklin Field crowds (110,087 total for the three final days) plenty to roar about.

Whatever your cup of tea, Penn once again delivered a nonstop multiplicity of varieties.

Stats-wise, performances generally were a tad shy of earth-shaking, list-busting.

But competition-wise, Penn as ever had a run of all the good things—down-to-the-wire decisions, sizzling splits, yelling-screaming-flag waving fans again putting the whole Relays experience in a category all its own.

It's always debatable: Is Penn "all about" the pros running the USA vs. the World series, or the "kids" of the college and scholastic ranks? As ever, there was no clear-cut decision.

The U.S. took three of six (3:02.40 men's 4x4; 42.28 women's

4x1 and 3:22.92 in the 4x4), but Jamaica powered to the men's 4x1 (38.33) and women's sprint medley (3:34.64) crowns, leaving the men's distance medley to Mo-

rocco (9:17.48 NR)

Big names again sparkled.

The Carmelita Jeter-anchored 4x1 was a Penn record and world leader. Allyson Felix did double duty, second legs in both the 4x1 and 4x4 (where Francena McCorory's 49.8 split was the meet's fastest.

But the Americans couldn't hold off the Asafa Powell-started, Steve Mullings-anchored Jamaica men's 4x1.

Completely overshadowed in all this was the prime-time return of Justin Gatlin to the national lineup. "This is just one race; there are plenty more to go, one thing at a time," he low-keyed after leading off USA Team Blue to a 38.66 in 3rd.

Again, there was "glory in it for all," the old line uttered by Penn State football coach Joe Paterno after his gridgers had set back one more worthy opponent.

As it turned out, it was a Penn State team that had to settle for "glory" after relegation to second place in the most dramatic Penn baton event of all, the men's Championship

Loxson (I) anchored the 4x8 in 1:46.70, but MVP Andrews countered with a 1:46.00

of America 4x8.

Randy Moore had anchored the '85 Nitany Lions to the longest-running Penn record of 7:11.17 but now—as almost every savvy fan in the stands knew—this one's longterm occupancy on the charts would be put to the ultimate test.

Why? Because both Penn State and Vir-

ginia came to Philly loaded, talent-packed and stoked.

Furthermore, their soph anchors were old friends and arch-rivals. UVa's Robby Andrews had won the '10 NCAA indoor 800 and outkicked Oregon Olympian Andrew Wheatling to win the Penn 4x8 in sensational 7:15.38 fashion. But he couldn't hold off Penn State's Casimir Loxsom in the USATF Junior or World Junior 800s.

So the stage was re-set and Andrews and Loxsom did not disappoint, It boiled down to a final 150-meter sprint and once

again Andrews proved why he's such dynamite in come-from-behind situations.

He gathered sensationally and then swept right past Loxsom coming off the final turn. His 1:46.00 carry brought his Cavs home in 7:12.15. Cas's consolation: a 1:46.70 split and a 7:12.90 team time, No. 6 on Penn's all-time charts.

"I just like guys on my team who hate to lose," said Cavs' coach Jason Vigilante.

"Is that true? It can't really. I don't believe it," said Andrews an hour after the meet, when someone told

him he'd been named the outstanding collegiate runner in the meet. It was both a huge honor and proof that he's 100% again after skipping the collegiate indoor season with foot issues.

It was a sensational Penn Relays, too, for Gabriel Mvumvure, the LSU senior from Zimbabwe who powered the Tigers to titles in the 4x1 (38.77) and 4x2 (1:20.62) and also found time to win the individual 100

(10.33)

LSU was the only school to double up on the men's side, as Texas A&M (3:01.73) 4x4, Princeton (16:19.98, 4xM, its first Penn win in 71 years), Villanova (9:37.93 DMR), Penn State (3:17.10 SMR) and Texas Texas (54.16 shuttles) had their moments, too.

But the A&M women registered a triple, (43.49 4x1, 1:29.96 4x2, 53.41 shuttles), leaving five others to claim wins: Texas (3:30.08 4x4), Duke (8:25.93 4x8), Boston College (17:25.19 4x15), Georgetown (10:51.49 DMR) and LSU (3:48.45 SMR).
