

— Shanghai DL: Xiang Liu Is Back —

Shanghai, China, May 15—Xiang Liu might have had a better setting for his first pro circuit race in a year, but it's hard to see how.

The 27-year-old Shanghai native brought some 30,000 fans to their feet at the second stop on the '11 Samsung Diamond League circuit and gave them full reason to roar with delight as he turned back last year's barriers lord David Oliver, 13.07–

But this time, it was all the former WR holder's show. He has changed his start, taking seven strides to the first barrier rather than eight. It appeared to make a world of difference as Liu, in lane 5, rocketed off the line to an immediate lead over the slower-starting American in 4.

Liu led all the way, taking a quick peek to his left after clearing the final obstacle. He was safe, although Oliver made up some of the margin in the late going. But

sure of your own race and not be affected by other athletes."

Oliver commented, "I just underperformed tonight and lost to a better hurdler, I'll just get ready for my next meet and train harder and work harder for my next performance."

Liu's victory now puts his career record versus Oliver at 8-1, the American's single win coming last year in Shanghai.

Jamaican sprint power showed itself in both 100s as Veronica Campbell-Brown and Asafa Powell held off determined charges by American challengers.

Campbell-Brown's sharp start gave her a two-foot lead over Carmelita Jeter, which VCB held for about 70 meters. Then Jeter began clawing back but she couldn't quite make up all the room as Campbell-Brown won in a year-pacing 10.92 (wind +1.2) ahead of Jeter's 10.95, her second-fastest time of the young season.

"I thought I executed well and I felt strong in the race," said Campbell-Brown. "But it's early in the season [and] I have a lot to work on. There's a lot of room for improvement."

Added Jeter, "Veronica had a really good start. I wasn't as good as I was supposed to be."

Before this meet, concerns were raised by Powell's previous competition, an eased-up 21.40 for 8th and last in the Kingston 200 on May 7. He had felt a hamstring

tighten after coming off the turn and slowed to prevent serious injury.

But in his yearly century debut, Powell got a solid start and held his slight lead over American Mike Rodgers for the entire distance. Rodgers kept whittling away the gap and Powell slowed noticeably in the final 10 meters. But the Jamaican held on

to win in a world-leading 9.95, 0.06 ahead of Rodgers.

"I didn't want to push it too hard tonight," said Powell, "[so] I'm surprised it was a sub-10. It was a good win; I felt very confident tonight."

In the women's 5000, Vivian Cheruiyot

looks to be in fine form for a Worlds defense as she won in a year-leading 14:31.92.

Despite a sagging pace in the middle of the race, the Kenyan outran Ethiopia's Sentayehu Ejigu (14:32.87), who was nearly caught by a furious close from Worlds 10,000 winner Linet Masai (14:32.95).

Olympic 1500 champion Asbel Kiprop couldn't respond to the final-stretch kick of Kenyan countryman Nixon Chepseba, who ran his second PR/world leader in as many races, this one at 3:31.42. He had won the DL opener in Doha a week ago at 3:31.84.

Kiprop followed at 3:31.76 and while disappointed, he noted, "I'm better this year than last year. I did 3:32 last year and now 3:31. So it's a good start to the season."

Notable on the field was the long jump win by Aussie Mitchell Watt.

The '09 Worlds bronze medalist matched his PR 27-8¼ (8.44) from his nationals in April.

He hit that mark again on his sixth leap after taking the led in second frame with 27-4½ (8.34).

Reigning world champ Dwight Phillips managed only a 26-5¼ (8.07) best for 4th in his season-opening competition.

Nordic rivals Tero Pitkämäki and Andreas Thorkildsen had another great javelin hookup, with the Finn matching the world lead at 279-11 (85.33).

Thorkildsen (279-3/85.12) looked hurt on his fifth try and passed his final effort.
