

### — Rome DL: Bolt Up & Running Again —

Eighty meters into the 100, the climactic event of the Rome Diamond League meet, Asafa Powell looked like he might accomplish something he hadn't managed since July '08: a win over Usain Bolt.

But it was not to be, as the long, lanky World Record holder powered ahead to a 9.91–9.93 win.

With his frantic finish, Bolt staved off what almost became a second straight loss in two races. This was his first competition in almost 10 months since Tyson Gay knocked off the Jamaican's mantle of indomitability in Stockholm last August.

Before the Italian encounter, Bolt said he had both shed weight and added muscle but admitted to a case of prerace jitters.

Afterwards, he said, "I got through my first race; I was so nervous. I got a bad start and then kind of started to panic."

He added that he would leave technical assessment to coach Stephen Francis. "My coach will analyze the race," he said. "I was not proud of the race."

Although he went through the motions of clowning for the crowd of 47,732 (many of whom were drawn by Bolt, Bolt and Bolt) before the race, Bolt reacted sluggishly to the gun (0.174) and was unable to produce the physics-defying, long-tall-man-short-quick getaway of his World Record races in Beijing.

Powell, in his second century start of the season, reacted better (0.133), and although the two Jamaican stars ran fairly

even at 25 meters—with French 20-year-old Christophe Lemaître also close at that juncture—Powell owned the middle portion of the dash. He opened perhaps a half-meter lead midrace, and in order to close it Bolt had to strain, with an effort written in his visage.

Lemaître charged to a 10.00 clocking in 3<sup>rd</sup>, the fourth-best time of his career with a less helpful wind (0.6) than in his three sub-10 marks. The Frenchman looked to overstride some later in the race; if he corrects that, faster times could lie ahead for him.

The Italian capital scored a coup in signing Allyson Felix and Sanya Richards-Ross, defending world champions in the 200 and 400, to a double faceoff at both

Felix easily won the 400 in a world-leading 49.81 off a beautiful homestretch run. Her seasonal best left Amantle Montsho, who was even coming off the final turn, 5 meters back. Richards-Ross, too, was well-positioned with 100 to go but

fell back as quickly as Felix shot forward and even gave up two places in the last 30 meters to fellow Americans Francena McCorory (50.70) and Debbie Dunn (50.79).

Richards-Ross's 50.98 left her as fourth American at the finish.

The 45-minute turnaround to part 2 of the double, the 200, was too much even for Felix, though. The '10 DL 200/400 titlist was never really in it, and her 22.81 ahead of Richards-Ross's 20.88 could not match Bianca Knight (22.64), Kerron Stewart (22.74) or Debbie Ferguson McKenzie (22.76).

On the field, world champ Brittney Reese long jumped 22-9¼ (6.94) on her fourth attempt, and the same distance on her sixth, to stop the mini-streak Funmi Jimoh had been on with Doha DL and Daegu IWC wins. Jimoh leapt 22-6½ (6.87) on her second try.

Over longer track distances, U.S. vet Khadevis Robinson stunned world champion M b u l a e n i Mulaudzi by charging off the final turn to a thoroughly unexpected 1:45.09–1:45.50 win, and Imane

Merga ruled the 5K. The Ethiopian's final lap to time 12:54.21 pulled him clear of Kenyans Isiah Koech (12:54.59) and Vincent Chepkok (12:55.29). Six runners broke 13:00 in the first race of '11 to see the barrier broached.
