

— Eugene DL: Where To Start? —

Eugene, Oregon; June 3–4—In a meet traditionally renowned for its distance running, the sprinters and hurdlers stole the show on an unseasonably warm Saturday morning at the 37th Prefontaine Classic at

Liu's desperate lean at the finish, the American-leaning crowd of 12,188 roaring its approval.

haps for an autograph, or to see or touch their hero.

The hurdles, it turned out, were a warmup for the two titanic 100-meter races held in a 10-minute burst just after noon.

First the women, where Carmelita Jeter showed why she has been the world's top-ranked sprinter the last two seasons.

She crushed a great field in 10.70, 0.16 up on fellow American Marshevet Myers, who PR'd at 10.86, followed by Jamaicans Kerron Stewart (10.87), the Olympic champion Shelly-Ann Fraser (10.95), and Sherone Simpson (11.00).

Had Alex Anderson, in lane 1, not been left in the blocks, she would surely have had her first sub-11.00 as well. As it was, Anderson made up plenty of ground and got 6th at 11.02.


Said Jeter, "I just

wanted to execute a good race. I wanted to finally start putting my good race together."

Fraser joined Liu as two of 13 Olympic champions to get beat over the two days.

The 10.70 broke Veronica Campbell-Brown's year-old meet record—one of six to be broken—and also eclipsed VCB's 2011 list-leader, one of 9 to be surpassed.

The men, not to be outdone, ran minutes later. After a recalled first start, when it appeared that Mike Rodgers got a reprieve, the Jamaican Steve Mullings—the surprise world leader at the start of the day, at

idyllic Hayward Field.

With the tailwind cooperating—legal winds for both 100s and the men's highs—and with the temperature already in the 70s when the meet began at the TV-mandated 10a.m., the fireworks began at 11:30 when American David Oliver (of the 12.89 PR) faced off against China's Liu Xiang (12.88) in the hurdles, two weeks after Liu had gotten the best of Oliver on his home turf in Shanghai.

Running in adjacent lanes, Oliver grabbed a small lead and held on despite

which he has spent in recuperation. Liu, the Athens gold medalist, was one of 13 Olympic champions to get beat over the two days (three distance races were held on Friday evening).

"I'm happy for the good performance," Oliver said. "I was able to get in a good rhythm and hold on."

Though he seemed to finish better, Liu said, "Close to the finish my speed and my power were not good." Hours after the meet had ended, a gaggle of local Chinese-Americans waited outside the stadium, per-

had already taken the WL in 9.79 in a race in Florida.

American Ivory Williams was 8th, and last, in 10.02, making it the deepest men's 100 ever, surpassing Doc Patton's last-place 10.03 at the Beijing Olympics.

Comebacking Justin Gatlin was merely 6th in 9.97, his fastest time in six years.

Mullings thus becomes No. 4 on the current Jamaican depth chart, trailing Usain Bolt (9.58), Asafa Powell (9.72) and Nesta Carter (9.78), by far the fastest foursome ever assembled by a single nation.

The distance races were not too shabby, of course, though Saturday had a hard time topping Friday's three exciting races—a European Record in the 10K by Mo Farah, an MR 5K for Vivian Cheruiyot, and a WR in the rarely run track 30k by the marathoner Moses Mosop.

In the 10, on a balmy, calm evening in front of some 3000 people—admission was free, so no count was made—Farah stayed at the rear of a large group of fellow Africans, as they passed the first half in a steady drumbeat of 64s and 65s at 13:26.

American Galen Rupp, who trains with Farah as part of the Oregon Project, warmed up for the race but was scratched by his coach, Alberto Salazar, because of a high pollen count. Chris Solinsky, the American recordholder, dropped out after seven laps with tightness in his left hamstring.

The tricontinental, 28-year-old Farah—born in Somalia, living in Portland with his

Russian wife and daughter, and a British national—finished best and led a string of eight other runners—two Ethiopians, five Kenyans, one Eritrean—under 27:00. Until Keneninsa Bekele ran 26:25 here three years ago, no one had broken 27:00 on U.S. soil.

Farah's 26:46.57 broke Mohamed Mourhit's 12-year-old continental record by 6 seconds and Jon Brown's 13-year-old British standard by 32. His own PR had been 27:28.86. Seven of the nine sub-27 finishers set PRs. That pushes Solinsky's historic 26:59.60 to 36th all-time, trailing 35 African-born runners.

Farah, who moved to Oregon in January, said, "I don't have as much experience at

9.89—burst to a big win in 9.80, with Rodgers not far behind with a PR 9.85. Among Americans, only Tyson Gay and Maurice Greene have run faster.

"It was great," Mullings said. "I've been training really hard this year. I'm not scared [of anybody]."

Later in the day, it was learned that Gay

10K as the rest of the guys. I just sat. In a major championship, it would be completely different." He generously said of Rupp, "What I ran he would have run. He's a great friend and training partner."

Solinsky, a late add to the field, said, "I thought I could handle 64s. They were surging. I was having trouble covering it. I need another week for my leg to heal. I didn't want to mess up the rest of the year."

Cheruiyot won the women's 5 in 14:33.96, a tenth of a second under Tirunesh Dibaba's year-old Hayward Field record. Then came three other Kenyans, the last of whom was American-educated Sally Kipyego, running in her new hometown of

Eugene, 4th in 14:39.71. Shalane Flanagan, who had hopes of challenging Molly Huddle's new AR of 14:44, ran out of steam late and finished 6th in an excellent 14:49.68.

"It was good to be in the mix," Flanagan said, "but that last lap got pretty ugly for me. I didn't have that pop. But it was a good opener."

For Kipyego, it was another step toward trying to make the Kenyan Olympic team. "Two years ago, I went to the Kenyan Trials and got lapped," she said. This year's national Trials are a month and a half away. Kipyego said she was undecided whether to try for the 5k or 10k.

In the 30K, the 2:03 marathoner Mosop ran 1:26:47.4 to wipe out Toshihiko Seko's WR by two and a half minutes. Along the way, he got a 25K WR of 1:12:25.2. His last two 10ks were both sub-29:00.

In the meet-concluding Bowerman Mile, Haron Keitany led three fellow Kenyans and Ethiopian Gebremedhin Mekonnen under 3:50, winning in a WL 3:49.09.

That WL was just 2 hours old, set in the earlier International Mile by Aussie Ryan Gregson at 3:53.86.

American Russell Brown was never in the Bowerman race, finished 9th, but ran a big PR of 3:51.45, #14 on the U.S. a-t list.

The women's 1500 was won by Gelete Burka in 4:04.63, as Morgan Uceny closed well to get 3rd in 4:06.32. Fellow American Christin Wurth-Thomas, fresh from her 4:03 in Rome a week earlier, was lead-

ing with 200 to go but appeared to run out of gas and faded to 10th. She reported later that she felt she had been tripped. "I am very, very happy," Burka said. "Four times I have won here."

The men's 2-mile had an intriguing bookend, as the 36-year-old veteran Bernard Lagat used a big finish to win in 8:13.62, 16 seconds ahead of the last-place finisher, 18-year-old Lukas Verzbicas, the Oregon-bound, Lithuanian-born prep from Illinois.

Verzbicas, shepherded much of the way by his own rabbit, Stephen Haas, broke German Fernandez's 3-year-old High School Record by 5 seconds.

What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is journalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean that the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL) and High School (HS).
