

### — NCAA Men: Texas A&M Defends —

Des Moines, Iowa, June 8–11—In an NCAA Championships beset by stormy weather and ennobled by Ngoni Makusha's triple, two truths emerged: Texas A&M has

built a dynasty and college track & field, despite protestations to the contrary, is a team sport featuring all the drama that American culture purports to appreciate.

In the final relay leg of the final race of the final day, Texas A&M won the 4x4 to secure a third successive men's/women's sweep.

No school had ever won both team titles three years in a row (more on the women in tomorrow's TN).

Heading into that 21st men's event, Florida State had 54 points, Florida 50 and A&M 45. Of the three, only FSU lacked an entry in the climactic relay.

Tabarie Henry, the collegiate leader at 44.83, ran a 44.86 anchor to finish off the Aggies' 19th straight victory in the event. Those 10 points gave A&M 55, 1 more than the Seminole and 2 more than the Gators.

A&M coach Pat Henry said it was the inability of quartermiler Henry—no relation to the coach—to qualify for the 400 final that galvanized the Aggies. Quartermiler Henry said he “knew it was over” after Bryan Miller's leadoff.

Henry added,

“It's a tremendous group of young people who did some things I don't think they could do at times this weekend. But they are big believers. During our meeting this morning, they all looked at each other and left the room knowing what needed to be done.”

Even the point totals don't reflect how close team standings were. For instance, the disqualification of apparent runner-up Gil Roberts of Texas Tech in the 400 moved A&M's Demetrius Pinder from 5<sup>th</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> and Miller from 8<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup>. Without those two extra points, A&M would have been outscored by Florida State 54–53.

It was another excruciating outcome for Florida, which has finished No. 2 four times and No. 3 once since '04. The Gators also lost by two to A&M, 48–46, in '09.

“We just had too many things go wrong for us to be the champions,” Florida head Mike Holloway said. “It's another two-point loss, and I'm almost at a loss for words. I am the guy in charge of the program, and I need to look at myself first. I need to figure out what we have to do to quit coming up short like this.”

Notable were the Gator failures in two events they were favored to win, the 100 and 4x1. Defending champ Jeff Demps cramped in the 100 and did not get out of the semifinals. The two-time defending Gators couldn't get the stick around in the sprint relay.

Yet as they ultimately came up short, the Gators were responsible for the meet's most compelling duel of the last day. In the triple jump, the lead changed four times before Christian Taylor prevailed over teammate Will Claye.

Best marks were wind-aided, although Taylor's 17.80/58-3/4w was a collegiate best under all conditions. The previous best was 17.72/58-13/4w by Arkansas's Mike Conley in '85. Claye was 2<sup>nd</sup> at 17.62/57-9/4w;

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his 17.35/56-11¼ in the third round was a school and Drake Stadium record.

Makusha, a 24-year-old Zimbabwean, set the lone Collegiate Record: 9.89 in the 100, breaking the mark of 9.90 set by UCLA's Ato Boldon in '96. He also broke Boldon's meet mark of 9.92.

The race was run over a track wet from one of the rainstorms that interrupted action on the middle two days. It wasn't so much that Makusha set the record, but the way he did so—extending the lead over the closing 30 meters in a finish reminiscent of vintage Carl Lewis.

Earlier Friday, Makusha passed his final attempt of a long jump competition suspended from Thursday by a lightning warning. His national record of 27-6¾ (8.40) represented his third title and the first half of the fifth 100/LJ double in NCAA history. Others were by Michigan's DeHart Hubbard ('25), Ohio State's Jesse Owens ('35 & '36), and Houston's Lewis ('81).

Makusha went them one better by adding

a third title in the 4x1 (there was no sprint relay until '64).

It was precarious. On the first exchange, Kemar Hyman passed to Makusha, who fumbled the baton. Hyman snatched the baton from mid-air flight and passed again to Makusha inside the zone.

Americans totaled 10 individual titles, one more than those from other nations.

Other highlights:

- Florida State's Maurice Mitchell won the 200 in 19.99w after finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> in the 100 in a PR 10.00.

- Virginia soph Robby Andrews completed a last-to-first stretch run with a closing 200 in 26.44 and won the 800 in 1:44.71, just 0.01 off the meet record held by Florida's Mark Everett since '90. UC Irvine junior Charles Jock led every step but the last, covering the first lap in a blistering 49.86.

- Oregon junior Matt Centrowitz achieved an NCAA title in the 1500, something his father, an Olympian, never did. Centrowitz was tactically superb, always staying near the front before finishing a 3:42.54 with a 53.38 last 400.

- After finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> in the storm-delayed 10,000 the night before, Liberty senior Sam Chelanga won the 5000 in 13:29.30. It was Chelanga's first title at the distance after finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> four times, including indoors this year. Iona's Leonard Korir, the 10K and indoor 5K champion, was 3<sup>rd</sup>.

- LSU's Barrett Nugent, after finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> to Illinois's Andrew Riley a year ago in the 110 hurdles, reversed the order with a 13.28w victory. Prerace favorite Omo Osaghae of Texas Tech crashed the first barrier and was effectively knocked out of the race.

- Washington State senior Jeshua Anderson, on a cool, windy and rainy Friday, won his third 400 hurdle title in 48.56.

- Illinois State soph Tim Glover won the javelin at 263-6 (80.33), becoming the fourth American to reach the B-standard for the World Championships.

- In a decathlon extending into a third day, an unprecedented 10 scores exceeded 7800. Cal's Mike Morrison won with 8,118. Duke frosh Curtis Beach capped a runner-up 8084 with a meet record of 3:59.13 in the 1500.

Beach's brilliant running also included marks of 10.78, 46.90 and 14.76)
