

— NCAA Women: A&M Defends Again —

Des Moines, Iowa, June 8–11—Texas A&M and Oregon spent most of the women's NCAA Championships counting points and casualties.

The Aggies scored enough of the former

Beard anchored in 49.13—fastest in meet history—to complete the Aggies' first-ever title in the event, at 3:26.21. Auburn (3:26.31) and Oregon (3:28.18). All three set new school records

way. You have to have 7th-place in the triple jump, that 5th-place in the 100 meters."

Opening day could have been disastrous for the Aggies. Jeneba Tarmoh, formcharted for 4th, false-started in her semifinal of the 100, and hurdlers Gabby Mayo and Natasha Ruddock both DNFed.

"When we went down in the hurdles, our ladies knew then, it's going to be extremely difficult to win this track meet and everyone is going to have to really be at their best," Henry said.

Oregon coach Vin Lananna said the disappointment of finishing as runners-up would motivate the young Ducks.

Hasay was tearful afterward, questioning the decision to double and saying she "didn't have it" in closing kicks. Yet the Ducks are clearly getting close: 28 of their 45 points were scored by frosh and sophs.

"You have to win one," Lananna told the *Eugene Register-Guard*. "You have to knock it out of the box, and when you knock it out, that's

when you come back the next year and know how to do it. We just have to keep maturing as the program progresses."

For instance, Oregon appeared poised to win two events on Day 3, and did so—in two other events.

Collegiate leader English Gardner, who

and limited enough of the latter to win a third straight team title over the luckless Ducks, 49–45.

It was a third straight runner-up finish for Oregon, which is still seeking its first outdoor championship since '85. Soph Jordan Hasay, who won a mile/3000 double indoors, led both the 5000 and 1500 late in these nationals before falling to 4th and 8th, simply not having the leg speed left to match her rivals in the closing stages.

The teams entered the climactic 4x4 tied at 39. Oregon was the defending champion, but A&M was the favorite.

Moreover, the Aggies had Jessica Beard.

with 43½ points and Oklahoma 4th with 42.

"Once I passed Oregon, I knew we had the team title clinched," Beard said. "But I kept thinking about last year and how badly I wanted to win the 4x4."

Oregon had led A&M 33–23 heading into the final day. With more scoring chances, the Ducks could have pulled away. But A&M scored 26 of a possible 30—2^{nds} in the 4x1 and 200 in addition to victory in the 4x4—to secure the first half of an unprecedented third straight men/women sweep.

Referring to Beard, Henry said, "It takes three in front of her to put her in position to do what she does. And the team is the same

was banged up when she fell in an Oregon 4x1 relay exchange, placed only 7th in the 100 after being predicted as No. 3.

In the 5000, Hasay pushed the pace over the last three laps but was overtaken by Villanova's Sheila Reid. Meanwhile, Anne Kesselring pulled away to victory in the 800 and Melissa Gergel upset CR holder Tina Sutej in the vault (both tying the meet record of 14-7¼/4.50).

The Bowerman Award, which goes to the top collegian in the sport, seemingly came down to four worthy candidates:

•Beard, who ran three quality 400s in little more than 24 hours. She clocked 50.95 in midday relay leg in a 4x400 semifinal suspended from the previous night by a storm warning, then completed an indoor/outdoor sweep with a 51.10 victory. She capped it all with the 49.13 carry the next afternoon.

•Reid won an unprecedented 1500/5000 double, featuring fast finishes for times of 4:14.57 (62.95) and 15:37.57 (64.54). With four NCAA titles, the junior from Newmar-

ket, Ontario, trails legends Vicki Huber (8), Jen Rhines (6), Carrie Tollefson (5) and Sonia O'Sullivan (5) in Villanova lore.

"I am truly blown away by how much power she has at the end of the race, and now there is absolutely no doubt that she can kick past anybody in any race," Villanova coach Gina Procaccio said.

•LSU soph= Kimberlyn Duncan won the 200 in a world-leading 22.24, completing an indoor/outdoor sweep. She was second in the 100 by 0.01 and ran anchor for a 4x1 team that won in 42.64, No. 2 in the world.

•Kansas State heptathlete Ryann Kraiss won her specialty with 5961 points. That doesn't complete her story. She also was third in the 400 hurdles (at 55.89, after a PR 55.68 in the prelims), then ran her hept 800 an hour later in 2:12.63.

Elsewhere on the track, Candyce McGrone followed the lineage of fellow Indianapolis natives Maicel Malone and Holli Hyce in becoming an NCAA sprint queen. In the absence of Tarmoh, the Oklahoma junior edged Duncan to claim the 100 in 11.08.

Colorado produced its third steeplechase champion in four years, Emma Coburn, in 9:41.14.

Elsewhere in the field, Arizona sophomore Julie Labonté finished a 12-0 season in the shot put and broke her own Canadian record with a distance of 60-1.

Clemson's Patricia Mamona repeated in the triple jump at 46-1¼.
