

— Euro Teams: Lemaître Down To 9.95 —

Stockholm, Sweden, June 18–19— There are still plenty of people who don't like the contrived field event rules that were introduced when the SPAR European Team Championships took over from the European Cup in '09.

However, when the wind blows in the

while Spiegelburg had two unsuccessful efforts before having to retire thanks to the idiosyncratic rules about a limited number of failures, and then had three missed at a Polish Record of 15-11½ (4.86).

The top track man of the weekend was, without doubt, Lemaître, who notched up a 100/200 double.

He sped to a French Record 9.95 on Saturday, with the sun and a legal breeze on his back, and then ran a hugely impressive 20.28 on Sunday, with rain and a biting wind in his face and on a sodden track.

It seems only a matter of time before the young Frenchman, who only turned 21 earlier this month, becomes the first European sprinter to go sub-10 and sub-20.

He might have done it in the same weekend had the elements not changed so dramatically overnight, which forced the men's vault indoors and postponed to the Sunday evening.

However, Russia was still crowned as the winners of the team title (sexes combined) for the second successive year, and the team were duly presented with their medals despite one event remaining.

They got 9 victories and consistently scored well in most of the other 40 events to put together a record tally of 385 points and finish 53½ clear of second-placed Germany, running up an unassailable lead with four events remaining.
