Going into the men's 400, Jeremy Wariner was the fastest on paper, bearing the only sub-45 of the season among the entrants. But subpar races at Pre and USATF showed that he is human after all.

Sure enough, after a solid start and looking good for 300 meters, the fading Texan (45.50) was run down by Chris Brown (44.94), Jonathan Borlée (45.05) and Jermaine Gonzales (45.43) in the straight.

Ethiopians Meseret Defar and Genzebe

world leader would catch Robles, but the Cuban held him off on the lean at the tape. With both sharing the same time of 13.09, this was one close race, as Robles ran his all-time record over Oliver to 17-4.

The women's shot went to evergreen New Zealander Valerie Adams in a meet record 68-2¼ (20.78), who for the third time in a row turned back former nemesis Nadzeya Ostapchuk (67-2¾/20.49).

Dibaba ran stride for stride in the early laps of the women's 5000, trailed by countrywoman Sentayehu Ejigu. Shalane Flanagan sat well back, 10 meters off the pace in no-man's-land, and would soon run one of the best races of her life.

With a furious last-lap sprint, Defar (14:29.52) prevailed over Ejigu (14:31.66) and Mercy Cheron (14:35.13), with Dibaba having dropped out.

For Defar, it was her record 8th sub-14:30 ever and a record 37th sub-15:00.

Flanagan came through like a rocket into 4<sup>th</sup>, finishing full of running, taking some good scalps and hitting a seasonal best of 14:45.20 that missed her PR by just 0.40 and the American Record by only 0.44.

With this sort of excellent pace judgment, she looks a strong World Champs 10K contender.

Dayron Robles of Cuba, not thought to be in good form, continued his domination of top American hurdler David Oliver (USA). Robles got a great start, leaving Oliver 2 feet to make up.

For 40 meters it looked like the

Birmingham, England; July 10—Birmingham got to show off its newly refurbished stadium, and filled it to its 12,500 capacity for the Diamond League meet. To give some idea of the depth of competition, 15 of the events featured World or Olympic Champions and more than 40 global medalists lined up.

There was no mistaking the vociferous crowd's favorite for the 5K. Mo Farah—one of Alberto Salazar's Portland training group—is a popular hero, and the crowd expected him to perform.

Pacemaker David Krummenacker kicked off with 63-second laps to bring the crowd through the kilo marker in 2:36.75. Following were the Ethiopian trio of Imane Merga, Abera Kuma, and Yenew Alamirew, with Farah and training partner Galen Rupp slowly moving through the field.

At halfway, the usual suspects were still at the front, along with Aussie Craig Mottram, trying to race himself into some good times before the World Champs.

The pace heated up with 3 laps to go, as Alamirew surged, followed by his countrymen, and Rupp—still looking very comfortable—tucked in behind. Mottram and countryman Collis Birmingham moved to the front as the pace slowed, with Rupp moving up to Mottram's shoulder. With two laps left, Farah appeared from out of thin air, tailing Mottram, with Rupp right behind.

The Briton's 13:06.14 was capped by a 54-second final lap had everyone's measure, despite a brilliant homestraight sprint by Rupp. Rupp's strong finish pulled him into 2<sup>nd</sup> at 13:06.76 ahead of world leader Merga (13:07.63) and Alamirew (13:08.78).

Rupp's time was a PR, moving him to No. 7 on the all-time U.S. list.

Said the winner, "It's so nice to win and finish 1-2 with Galen. People have asked me about my move to the United States, but as an athlete you've always got to be looking at how to improve yourself and what you can do better."

All eyes were on Asafa Powell after he dominated his heat of the 100 meters, easing up in the last 15 meters. The sprinters

were clearly jumpy, with a false start by Norway's Jaysuma Saïdy Ndure putting him out of the race. Then Keston Bledman did not hold his set position, and popped off the blocks, without DQ.

Once the race was underway, Powell made it no contest, with an easy win over fellow Jamaicans Carter and Frater, as he slowed down over the final 10 meters.

His winning time of 9.91 was his 70<sup>th</sup> sub-10. More of them than Tyson Gay and Usain Bolt combined.

Brimming with confidence, Powell said, "At the Worlds I'm definitely going to win. I'm going for it and I'll try not to disappoint."

After exciting heats for the women's 100 hurdles, won by Australian Sally Pearson (12.57) and American Danielle Carruthers (12.61), the final promised to be a close and exciting race. And so it was.

Pearson, running with remarkable hurdling form, held off four Americans, led by Carruthers, Ginnie Crawford, Kelli Wells and Kristi Castlin. Pearson's 12.48 set Australian and meet records in addition to being a world-leading time.

Andreas Thorkildsen joined Pearson atop a yearly list. His groin woes apparently behind him, the Norwegian star sent his javelin on a 289-8 (88.30) journey and had three other 280-footers in his series.

Irish rabbit Karen Shinkins led the women's 1500 field for the first lap in 64.08 from Maryam Jamal, Kalkidan Gezahegne, Mimi Belete, Lisa Dobriskey and Morgan Uceny.

Belete kept the pace up in the second lap, followed by Jamal, Dobriskey, Gezahegne, and Uceny. The eagles gathered in the third lap, bunching up, with Belete holding off Uceny and Helen Clitheroe, who had moved up the field.

But no one could match Uceny's sprint over the last 200, as the USATF champ simply blew them away, winning in 4:05.64 from Gezahegne (4:05.96), and Jamal (4:06.39).

Americans Christin Wurth-Thomas (4:08.10) and Treniere Moser (4:08.16) finished 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>.
