

— Monaco DL: Farah Wins Hot 5K, AR For Lagat —

Fontvieille, Monaco, July 22—No surprise that Usain Bolt's name generated the biggest buzz at the 10th stop on the Samsung Diamond League Circuit, the 25th anniversary Herculis meet in this playground of the wealthy perched on the shore of the Mediterranean.

and deep results.

Midway through the meet's program, a stellar men's 5000 field saw veteran Bernard Lagat make good on his desire to lower his American Record as the 36-year-old dualed over the last lap with Britain's Mo Farah and Kenya's 17-year-old sensation Isiah Koech.

the 12:54.12 he ran last year in Oslo. Koech followed in 3rd, cutting his World Youth Record to 12:54.18—0.01 faster than Ethiopia's Abreham Cherkos ran in '09.

While pleased to revise his AR, Lagat confessed to some disappointment that he didn't run his hoped-for 12:49, a time that would have put him in the Top 10 of all-time.

"I do have mixed emotions," Lagat told Universal Sports. "I'm happy I was able to lower my personal best by a little bit, but I'm a little disappointed I didn't get what I planned to do all season."

"I'm disappointed because I've always wanted to run super-fast and these opportunities don't come around often in my event."

The race results say "DNF" by the names of both Galen Rupp and Chris Solinsky, as the American pair both felt victim to roller-derby racing in the large, bunched field. Rupp went down after Kenyan Lucas Rotich tripped in mid-race.

Solinsky got unceremoniously pushed off the track with a few laps to go

as Imane Merga shoved the American from behind to grab an inside position. The Ethiopian was not DQed for his blatant foul.

In arguably the most remarkable of the many-lap contests, Kenya's reigning Olym-

Farah, coached by Alberto Salazar, got the win and a British record, 12:53.11, while Lagat lowered the AR to 12:53.60



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While Bolt caused as many headlines for his narrow 100 win at 9.88, just 0.02 ahead of fast-starting Jamaican countryman Nesta Carter, four superb distance races produced drama, high-level competition

Farah led into the final stretch and Lagat gave determined chase all the way home as the Briton clocked a national record, and year-leading, 12:53.11.

Lagat's 12:53.60 lowered his AR from

pic steeple champion Brimin Kipruto came within a bare 0.01 of tying the 7:53.63 World Record set in '04 by Qatar's Saif Shaheen. With two laps left in the hurdles-and-splash 'chase, the Kenyan trio of Paul K. Koech, Kipruto and '04 Games winner Ezekiel Kemboi ran within a stride of each other.

Koech and Kipruto edged ahead of Kemboi down the final backstraight, Koech—seeking to impress Kenyan selectors after placing only 7th in his nationals to cast doubt on his Worlds selection despite his preeminence on the DL circuit this sum-

mer—spurred with about 250 left to run.

Kipruto didn't let go and moved into the lead heading into the final turn. He hurdled the final water barrier, landing in deeper water which may have slowed him slightly.

But it was an awkward, arms-akimbo clearance of the final barrier in the homestretch that hurt Kipruto most. He sprinted for the finish with all he had and crossed in 7:53.65, just 0.02 shy of the global mark. The time was officially amended to that galling 0.01 shy moments later.

Kemboi rallied to finish 2nd in a PR 7:55.76 to move to No. 4 all-time, while Koech also dipped under 8:00 with 7:57.32, just ticks short of his PR 7:56.32 from '05.

The first seven placers ran under 8:10, with the following five under 8:18. In 11th, U.S. champ Billy Nelson trimmed his best to 8:17.27, cutting down his career-best by more than 4.0.

“The race was so fast for everyone, I didn't even know it was World Record pace,” said the 25-year-old Kipruto. “When

I saw the clock, I was just so grateful. Next time at the Worlds, I will try to break the World Record.”

In the first of the top-class distance races, a non-DL 1500, Kenyan Silas Kiplagat spurred to the front ahead of countryman Nixon Chepseba and held off the chasing pack with a 54-second final lap to lower his '11 leader to 3:30.47.

Chepseba cut his best to 3:31.74, just 0.02 ahead of the big PR 3:31.76 by Sudan's elite

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800 man Abubaker Kaki. New Zealand's Nick Willis followed in an NR 3:31.79.

In 10th, U.S. and NCAA champion Matthew Centrowitz trimmed his PR down to 3:34.46, 0.23 faster than his previous DL race in Paris two weeks ago. Andrew Wheating withdrew just before this race due to a tight hamstring.

Last, but certainly not least, in the multi-lap races, the men's 800 saw '10 AOY David Rudisha display regal dominance as the

World Record holder took over with some 350 meters left and simply ran away from the field.

The Kenyan had to hold his form all the way home, reached in a season-leading 1:42.61, to hold off the strong closing rush by Olympic 1500 champion Asbel Kiprop, whose 1:43.15 but his PR by 0.30. Nick Symmonds lowered his U.S.-leading clocking to 1:43.83, just 0.07 off his career-best.

The steeple concluded the meet; the race just before it was Bolt's much-anticipated century, his last 100 before a Worlds title defense in Daegu. The Jamaican superstar got a mediocre start in lane 3, notably trailing teammates Michael Frater in 5 and Nesta Carter in 7.

Bolt didn't appear to take the lead from

Carter until about a dozen meters remained in the race and he just edged ahead, 9.88-9.90. Mike Rodgers closed in 9.96 as Frater (10.01) faded. French hero Christophe Lemaître got a dismal start which doomed him to 5th in 10.03.

Before the race, Bolt had commented, "I've said all season long that I have to keep working on some things and it's getting better. I'm working hard and it's coming together."

Afterward, he assessed his race, "Technically, it was a good race. It wasn't the best start. Other than that, I think I executed well overall."

Carter said, "I thought I had him. But in the last 20 meters, I messed up right there." Despite their words, more than a few observers thought Bolt looked decidedly human in this race.

In the women's 200, Carmelita Jeter ran the opening turn hard and entered the final stretch with a slight lead ahead of Allyson Felix. The U.S. 100 champion held off the three-time Worlds 200 winner with her 22.20 PR, Felix finishing 0.12 behind. Jeter is now 2-1 vs. Felix in career half-lappers.

The dominating 400 win by Amantle Montsho at a year-pacing 49.71 showed that the Botswanan will be formidable challenger to Felix's planned 200-400 double in Daegu, as well as to the defense of reigning one-lap champion Sanya Richards-Ross.

Montsho lowered her PR from a 49.83 at altitude in '08, dominating the field. Francena McCorory whacked 0.20 off her all-time best that had given her 2nd at USATF in lane June.

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is journalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean that the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL) and High School (HS).
