

— Stockholm DL: Bolt Wins, Merritt Returns —

Stockholm, Sweden, July 29—Usain Bolt won unchallenged; Yelena Isinbaeva won in her first appearance in a Diamond League meet; Carmelita Jeter, Silas Kiplagat, Paul Koech and Valerie Adams continued to win; and Jason Richardson and Kalise Spencer scored unexpected wins.

from a doping suspension and showed he is on track to mount a competitive defense of his 400 world title in about a month.

Merritt clocked 44.74 behind the victorious 44.69 by Jamaican Jermaine Gonzales after leading into the homestretch from his lane 2 position. Gonzales collared Merritt only in the closing 25 meters, while the '08

Afterward, Merritt told T&FN in an exclusive chat, "44.74 isn't bad. It felt good to do what I love to do. I'd like to thank the meet director [Rajne Söderberg] for giving me this opportunity.

Bolt, who complained of a sore back, won the 200 easily in a pedestrian 20.03, although the field ran into a not-unsubstantial 1.2mps headwind.

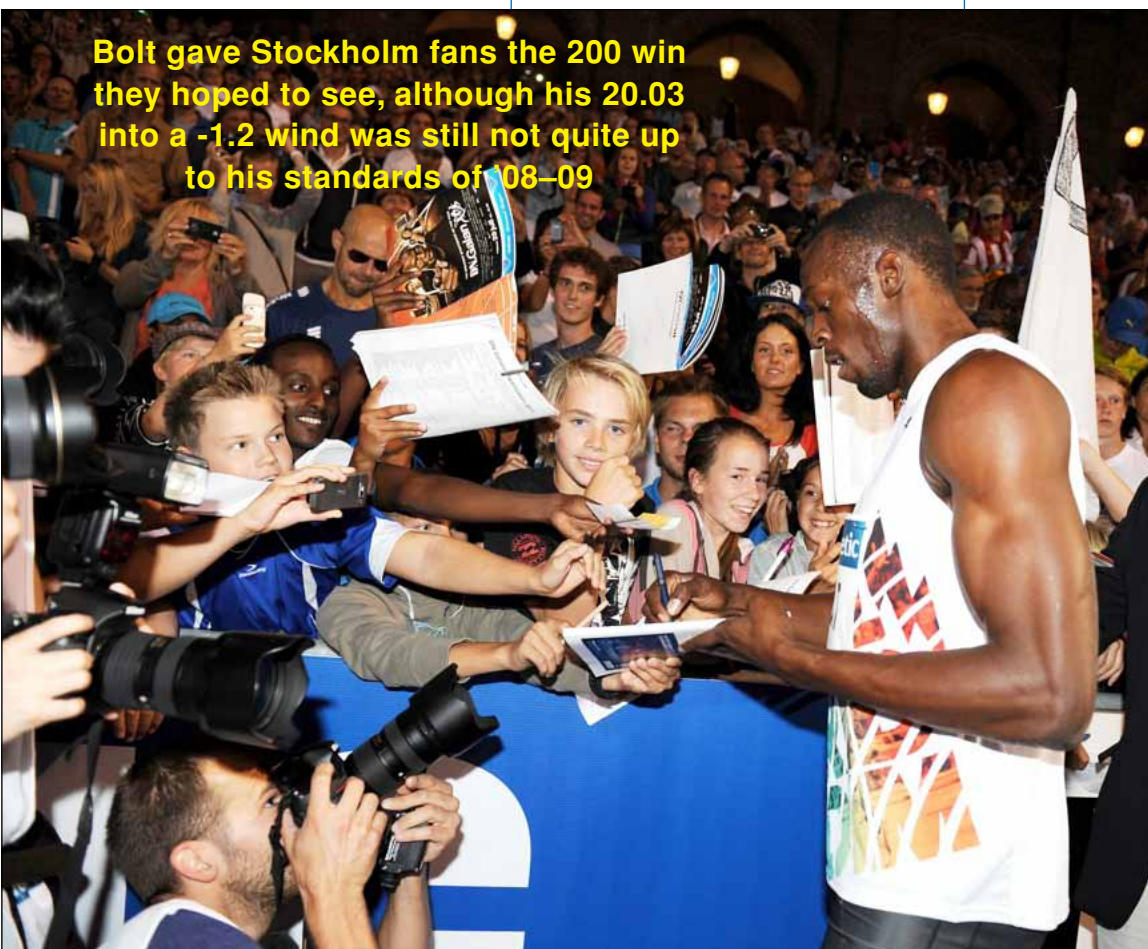
Jeter's 100 win was similarly convincing, her 11.15 run into an even-stiffer 2.4mps breeze as she won comfortably from Marshevet Myers (11.21) and Keron Stewart (11.27).

Kiplagat closed his 3:33.94 win, his third DL 1500 victory in a row, with a low-55 last lap to outdistance Asbel Kiprop (3:34.42) and Nick Willis (3:34.49). Koech surged to the front of the steeple with 500 to go and ran away to an 8:05.92 victory,

easily ahead of Uganda's Benjamin Kiplagat (8:14.42).

ams reached 67-6 (20.57) to outdistance Nadzeya Ostapchuk (66-10/20.37) and Jillian Camarena-Williams (65-2¼/19.87). All got their longest heaves on their second puts.

Worlds defender Christian Cantwell got his winning 71-2½ (21.70) in round 5, which withstood the closing 70-10½ (21.60) by Olympic champion Tomasz Majewski. They were the only throwers to exceed 70-feet.

Isinbaeva continues her return from taking last season off, although her vaulting showed she still needs polishing. She made

her 15-2¼ (4.64) opener like a novice: back to the bar and landing in the pit on all fours and nearly face-first, which brought a smile from the WR holder.

But Isi cleared the winning 15-7¼ (4.76) on her first try, while 2-3-4 placers Silke Spiegelburg, Jenn Suhr and Svetlana Feofanova could not. The Russian star then missed all three at 15-11¼ (4.86).

"The competition and the technique were okay. It was nice to be back," said Isinbaeva. "I had no expectations about heights and just wanted to win."

Richardson outpaced a sluggish-appearing David Oliver, 13.17 to 13.28 as the hurdlers ran into a 2.3mps wind. AR holder Oliver hit seven barriers, the last five in a row. WR holder Dayron Robles withdrew due to a sore ankle.

Spencer hurdled one lap in 53.74, despite chopping her stride at the last two barriers, to easily handle the late-race challenge from Worlds defender Melaine Walker (54.71).

The wind played with the men long jumpers, but Aussie Mitchell Watt got the

season's first 28-plus leap as he extended his year-leader to 28-¼ (8.54) in round 2 with a 1.7mps boost. That leap withstood the windy third-frame 27-6¼ (8.40) by Moroccan Yehya Berrabah. Olympic champ Irving Saladino spanned 26-10½ (.8.19) for 3rd.

In the meet's most notable solo effort, Kenya's tiny Vivian Cheruiyot pushed her 5-1 /84 (1.55/38) frame to the front of the 5000 after the second rab-

bit dropped off at 2K. The Worlds defender just kept on running, her metronome-like stride eventually carrying her to a victory margin of close to 150 meters.

Her 14:20.87 PR cut her best from '07's 14:22.51 and strengthens the hold of the 27-year-old on No. 3 performer all-time. Following well back, Sally Kipyego (14:43.87) held 2nd from Sylvia Kibet (14:45.31) and American Shalange Flanagan (14:46.80).
