

— Promising U.S. Marks As DL Takes A Break —

London, England; August 5–6—Now comes the calm before the storm. With the staging of the 2-day Aviva Grand Prix, the sport will hibernate slightly, taking 3 weeks off from the grind of the European Circuit before bursting back to life at the World Championships in Daegu (August 27–September 4).

As with last year, the big British meet was staged over two days, although this time around it only had half as many Diamond League events as in the series' first installment.

The weekend's fun and games helped clarify quite a few Daegu medal choices and brought smiles to quite a few U.S. faces.

Smiliest of all may have been comebacking Sanya Richards-Ross, who produced her first sub-50 since September of '09, and once again looked like the 400's reigning world champion.

She was out strongly and gave up only a little to Rosemary Whyte's PR of 49.84 as she came home in a U.S.-leading 49.66.

"It's been a long, hard season for me and I haven't really been able to get my rhythm and run sub-50 seconds said Richards-Ross.

"It's taken longer than I thought to put things together, but now I feel ready to defend my title."

SRR was just 1 of 10 U.S. winners. Statistically speaking, the best U.S. mark was Christian Taylor's joining of the 58-foot club in the triple jump. The newly mint-

ed pro used a big third phase to hit 58-1/4 (17.68) on his third attempt and move to No. 7 on the all-time U.S. list. In the process, he also claimed the scalp of reigning world champ Phillips Idowu.

Non-Americans won the first day's two

en's full-lap version, and appeared to have lots left as she powered down the home-stretch to cross the line in a world-leading 52.79, whacking a big 0.54 off her previous best. The time moved her to =No. 8 ever.

Later in the evening came an eagerly

awaited rematch over the big sticks between WR holder Dayron Robles and reigning No. 1 David Oliver.

The Cuban ran almost flawlessly in slipping over the barriers in 13.04. The American banged the first hurdle hard and was in catch-up mode the whole way.

At 13.19, he wasn't even close. Meanwhile, Robles did get a bit of a race from Jason Richardson, who confirmed that his Stockholm win over Oliver was no fluke as he PRed at 13.08 and now must be viewed as a most viable medal candidate.

Before the meet, one event whose WC favorite had seemed hard to pin down was the men's 400.

Given the smooth and powerful run by still-only-18 Kirani James at Crystal Palace, it appears that a favorite has emerged.

His world-leading 44.61 moved him to No. 2 on the all-time Junior list, and it looked as if there were a lot more there.

The big summit meeting in the 800 be-

tween David Rudisha and Abubaker Kaki proved to be somewhat anticlimactic. The two superstars were so eager to go at it that they made it hard for rabbit William Tangui even to get to the front.

After dashing from the outside down the backstretch, he was finally in place and brought the principles through the halfway point in 49.61 and stepped off the track some 60 meters later.

From there, it was just a matter of Kaki chasing Rudisha but not making any headway as the Kenyan won handily, 1:42.91–1:43.13. It was the eighth sub-1:43 of the WR holder's career.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean tha the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.
