ATTENDANCE

Stadium capacity as used (top deck tarped-off except for first-night Opening Ceremony) was about 34,000, including VIP section. There were no morning sessions on 9/3 or 9/4. The attendance figures (seats sold, not necessarily occupied): 8/27—25,071/46,123; 8/28—22,040/32,464; 8/29—29,327/30,261; 8/30—31,448/31,490; 8/31—road race only; 9/1—31,284/30,564; 9/2—32,562/33,715; 9/3—33,772; 9/4—35,194 = 446,305.

Official temperature—both F and C—and humidity readings are given with each event.

EXPLAINING THE TYPOGRAPHY

Paragraph breaks in the preliminary rounds of running events indicate the separation between qualifiers and non-qualifiers.

COLOR CODING

All medalists appear in blue ink; all Americans are in bold face and italics (if in multiple rounds, only in the final round in which they competed); field-event/multi medalists appear in either blue (gold medal), red (silver) or green (bronze) in the progression charts.

SPLIT TIMES

Times in 10ths were taken by the *T&FN* split crew (virtually completely by video analysis); times in 100^{ths} are eyebeam times from the official timer, Seiko. Thanks to Mark Butler for his invaluable work in helping with the 4x4 splits (“e” marks are derived by formula from eyebeam times taken at the incorrect spot).

FIELD CHARTS

In the by-round field charts (all throws, horizontal jumps), the athlete’s best of the day is underlined. The asterisked marks represent the progression of the lead.

WHAT’S IN VERSION ii?

Note that this newsletter is marked as “version ii”; this means history tells us that more small amendments will roll in as more tape is watched and more sources are uncovered. While we won’t e-mail you the updated version, we will make a note of it in a subsequent *TN* and if you wish you’ll be able to download it from the Archive.
