

— Kiprotich Misses Marathon WR By 4 Seconds —

Frankfurt, Germany; October 30—Despite a magnificent effort over the final 5 kilometers of the BMW Frankfurt Marathon, Wilson Kiprotich (also sometimes known as Wilson Kipsang) fell just 4 seconds short of countryman Patrick Makau's World Record of 2:03:38, set in Berlin 5 weeks ago.

There was some scant consolation that his repeat victory in Germany's financial capital was a new course record, more than a minute faster than his 2:04:57 from last year, and that this time may give him a leg up on the final spot remaining on the Kenyan Olympic team.

The race went exactly as Kiprotich had planned it, until just after 30 kilometers. An early morning shower had given way to a still, slightly misty morning, with temperatures rising from 11C at the 10am start to around 14C at the finish (52–58F); just about perfect conditions for a marathon.

A group of 15 went through 10K in 29:25, diminishing to a sextet at halfway in 61:40, 4 seconds faster than Makau in Berlin. Deriba Merga of Ethiopia, who finished 4th in the Beijing Olympics, was still in the lee of the pacemaker, Peter Kirui of Kenya, who was reproducing his metronomic feats from Berlin last month; but so were relative unknown Kenyans Levy Matebo and Albert Matebor.

But it was clear that the pace was dropping when Kiprotich went up onto Kirui's shoulder at around 33K, and when the defending champion saw at 35K that he was

heading for a 2:04 finish, he took off by himself.

If the winner had ever been in any doubt, that issue was settled right then. It was Kiprotich against the clock. And what a race he made of it.

He sailed away from his pursuers, and clawed back 2–3 seconds per kilometer on the record chase, with the crowds out on the streets, and watching on the big screens at the indoor finish in the Festhalle willing him on.

Fireworks and floodlights greeted him for the final meters on the red carpet in the Festhalle, but the record effort was just in vain as he ran 2:03:42. Kiprotich had promised a WR, but given the way he chased it in the final stages, no one was going to cavil that he failed to deliver.

And if the 29-year-old Kenyan was disappointed, he didn't show it. "It's OK," he said at the finish, "I'm very happy with the time. The pacemaking was fine, they did a good job. I'll try to do it next year; this has given me even more motivation".

Matebo and Matebor revised their previous bests by more than 2:00 and close to 4:00 respectively; and pacemaker Kirui hung in to finish 6th in 2:06:33, no mean feat in itself.

There were 9 Kenyans in the first 10, Siraj Gena of Ethiopia being the interloper in 8th. Another record was

the 14 under 2:10, the most ever.

Kiprotich's time was clearly the second fastest in history, behind Makau, but 17 seconds ahead of the great Haile Gebrselassie, whose 2:03:59 has taken a bit of a battering in recent weeks.

Incidentally, all three sub-2:04 times have been set in Germany, Makau and Geb in Berlin, and now Kiprotich in Frankfurt, an appropriate 30th anniversary present for the country's oldest city marathon.

The German magic worked in the women's race too, with Mamitu Daska of Ethiopia taking almost a minute and half off Kenyan Caroline Kilel's record of 2:23:25 from last year.

For more than half the race, Daska was preceded by her young colleague, Merima Mohammed. But the 19-year-old fell away in the latter stages, while Agnes Kiprop of Kenya rallied, to finish 2nd in 2:23:54, with another Kenyan, marathon debutante Flomena Chepchirchir 3rd in 2:24:21.
