

### — NCAA Men's XC: Lalang & Wisconsin —

Terre Haute, Indiana; November, 21—Top-ranked Wisconsin burst from the starting line to run away from the challenge of 2-time defending champ Oklahoma State to win its fifth national crown since '82.

Throughout the season the Badgers seemed to be running five guys in one singlet, yet coach Mick Byrne decided to ditch the pack-strategy and sent his troops to the front, explaining, "We put ourselves in great position; we went after the title. We always talk about running Badger-tough and they showed that today."

Big 10 champ Mo Ahmed led the charge, running in the lead pack to finish 5<sup>th</sup> (3<sup>rd</sup> in the team race). Seniors Elliot Krause and Ryan Collins were not far behind in 17<sup>th</sup> (13<sup>th</sup>) and 23<sup>rd</sup> (19<sup>th</sup>), and Reed Connor grabbed the 36<sup>th</sup>-place (27<sup>th</sup>) stick.

Maverick Darling made the most of a difficult day and sealed the deal finishing 46<sup>th</sup> (35<sup>th</sup>) as the Badger's No. 5 man got home before any other team's No. 4.

Wisconsin's 97 points was comfortably clear of Oklahoma State (139), and the annual late charge of Colorado (144). BYU (203) won a tight 3-team battle for the 4<sup>th</sup>-place trophy, edging Stanford (207) and Oklahoma (213).

Arizona's Lawi Lalang finished off a most impressive frosh harrier season—he ran outdoors on the track last season—with a convincing 28:44 win.

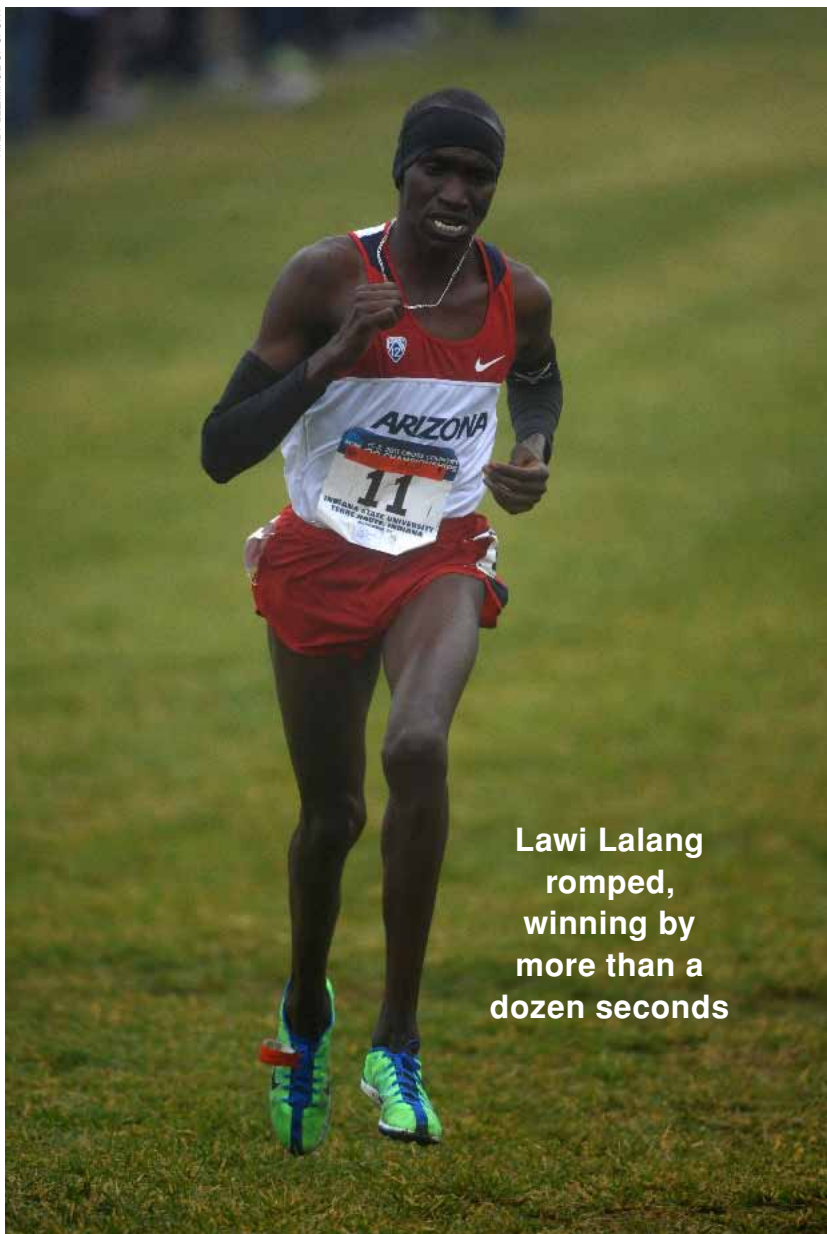
"The plan was to wait until 5K," the Kenyan star admitted, but 10 minutes into the chase he began to tug at the pace, and at 4K he surged ahead with only

Leonard Korir and Cam Levins able to stay close.

After passing 5K in 14:21, Lalang launched ahead in long loping strides seemingly mismatched

for cross country terrain. Appearances aside, Lalang sped ahead to a 13-second win over Stanford's Chris Derrick who logged four top-10 finishes (7<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>) in his NCAA career.

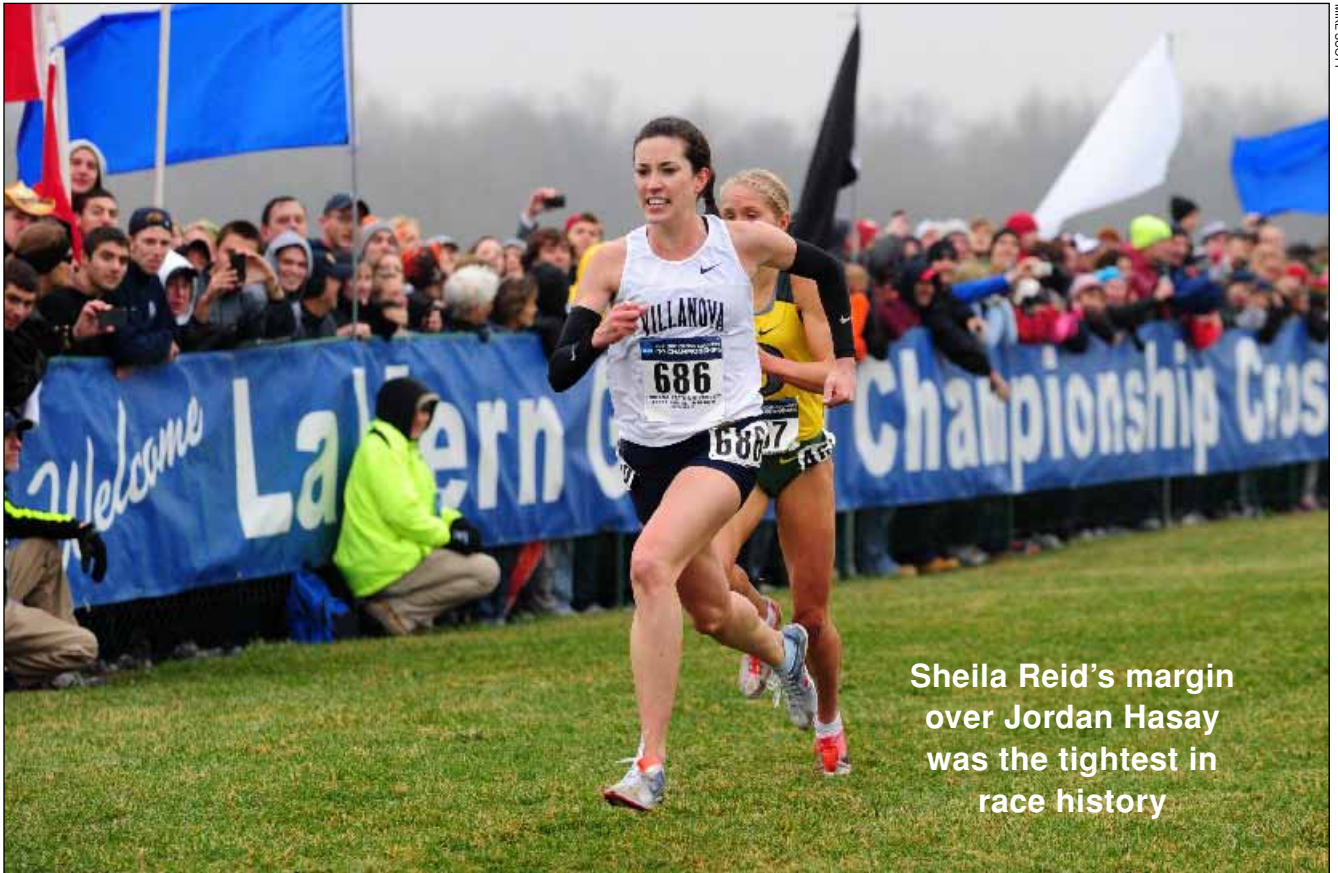

# — NCAA Women's XC: Reid & Georgetown —

Sheila Reid's margin over Jordan Hasay was the tightest in race history

Terre Haute, Indiana; November 21—The 2011 NCAA Women's Cross Country Championships will long be remembered for incredibly competitive team and individual competitions.

Defending champ Sheila Reid prevailed in yet another thrilling sprint win over Jordan

Hasay, but Reid and her Villanova mates fell just short of a threepeat as Georgetown won its first team title.

Reid's 19:41.2 gave her an 0.6-second margin of victory, the smallest in meet history. The previous low was Reid's 2.3 from last year.

They were followed across the line in close succession by Abbey D'Agostino of Dartmouth (19:42.9), Emily Infield of Georgetown (19:44.3), Alex Banfich of Princeton (19:45.0) and Bogdana Mimić of Villanova (19:45.7).

SMU's Silje Fjørtoft sped to a 30-meter lead in the first kilometer leaving a large chase pack clumped together, keyed into Reid's pacing.

The pack caught the Norwegian in the fifth kilometer, but even as Reid lifted the pace, 9 runners were still in contention heading into the final straight.

Reid admitted, "I had to believe with all those girls still there that I had the best kick of anyone. I was hurting but smiling inside.

"Jordan went and I stayed on her, and then moved past her and

I knew I had it."

The team competition was just as close as prerace favorite Florida State got out slowly while Washington, Villanova and Georgetown went toe-to-toe-toe in a battle for every point.

Villanova had Reid and Mimić in the lead group, Washington had Katie Flood and Megan Goethals, while Georgetown only had Infield in low-stick position.

Trailing Washington by 22 points at 3K, Coach Chris Miltenberg's Hoyas—who endured a string of injuries over the season—finished in a hurry to eke out a 162–170 win over the Huskies with Villanova 3<sup>rd</sup> at 181 and Florida State closing to 4<sup>th</sup> in 189.

Infield, last year's runner-up, finished 4<sup>th</sup> (3<sup>rd</sup> in the team score), then the Hoyas packed four runners in nine seconds with Claire Richardson 50<sup>th</sup> (33<sup>rd</sup>), Emily Jones 54<sup>th</sup> (36<sup>th</sup>), Kirsten Kasper 64<sup>th</sup> (44<sup>th</sup>), and Katrina Coogan 67<sup>th</sup> (46<sup>th</sup>).
