

— USATF Indoor Championships —

ALBUQUERQUE, NEW MEXICO, February 25–26—For the third year in a row, the Albuquerque Convention Center hosted the USATF Championships (with years 4 and 5 apparently locked down for '13 and '14).

As always, the 1512 meters (4960 feet) of altitude were wonderfully helpful to speed-based events and detrimental to those requiring endurance.

The first two in each event were eligible

for the World Championships team if they had met standard, but many had not. And many apparent qualifiers say they're skipping the IAAF's Istanbul meet in this Olympic year. The naming of the team is still pending.

Men: "A Pretty Good Team"

Istanbul is 2 weeks away. London is just 5 months ahead.

It's time to get with it, to get going, get the show on the road.

A heap of American men got that message at the Nationals, and delivered some resounding results in the Land Of Enchantment.

"We're going to have a pretty good team," declared men's head coach John Moon when the final finals were in the books.

"Better than pretty good, actually. Sure the rest of the world's catching up, but we have some great people, too."

The confidence factor will be key. Moon's sureshot leadership message: "This will be no Turkey trot."

There's a new world-list leader—dashman Trell Kimmons (6.45) on this team. And there might have been another if Dexter Faulk (after a 7.40 prelim in the 60 hurdles) hadn't false started

out of the final.

There's sure medal hopes in Aries Merritt (7.43) and Kevin Craddock (7.46) in the hurdles; Bernard Lagat (7:47.54), Jesse Williams (7-6), Brad Walker (19-2¾), Will Claye (57-10¼), plus Reese Hoffa (71-4¼) and Ryan Whiting (70-10½).

And surprise long jump champion Ashton Eaton (PR 26-5½ after the favored Claye fouled 4 of his 6 attempts) will clearly be the heptathlon choice, and a wagering-man's pick to extend his current WR of 6568.

Oh yes, USA may not have the individual 400 choice but with a 4x4 squad headed by Gil Roberts (45.39), Calvin Smith (46.07), Frankie Wright (46.07) and (maybe) collegian Brycen Spratling (46.16), relay gold is likely, too.

Don't let the jogging-paced, furious-finishing, altitude-impacted 1500 results—Leo Manzano (3:48.05) over Matthew Centrowitz (3:48.16)—shock you, either. The world knows they can go worlds faster.

The Visa Champions Series \$25,000 jackpot check went to Galen Rupp, off his 8:09.72 in Fayetteville two weeks ago. But all he could claim here was a pair of 3rds.

USATF Women: AR For Chaunté Lowe

Some analysts will claim that three yearly world list leaders head the U.S. women's team bound for the World Indoor Championships.

Let's see:

There's Tianna Madison, back in '05 the World Outdoor long jump champion, and now recast as world 60 sprint leader with a pair of 7.02s, first at Fayetteville and now again in the USATF Championships.

There's Sanya Richards-Ross, back in '09 World Outdoor 400 gold medalist's form, with her meet record/world-leading 50.71.

There's Kristi Castlin, the ex-Virginia Tech, now the year's speediest 60 hurdler at 7.84.

But others will allege that resurgent high jump star Chaunté Lowe (AR winner at 6-7½), shot put stalwarts Jill Camarena Williams (64-2¼) and Michelle Carter (63-2¾ PR), or long jump aces Janay DeLoach (22-7¼ twice) and Brittney Reese (22-6¼) are the heart of the USA team.

It would be hard to challenge Lowe's position of leadership. It's tough to argue with a mom (of two daughters.).

Her win—which followed a 20-11¾ for 6th in the long jump—clinched the Visa Champions Series title and the 25 grand bonus it carried.

"I knew the record was really possible today; I was just forcing myself not to make mistakes," she said. "And, oh yes, this was definitely my best indoor competition ever."

Jenny Simpson was the meet's only double gold medalist (9:19.15 on Saturday; 4:15.04 on Sunday).

Jenn Suhr took the vault at 15-3¾ despite an aching Achilles.

And here's one for the books—the 3000 walk's finish (Maria Michta 13:15.31 over Erin Gray 13:15.35) was as close as the 60 dash (Madison's 7.02 over Barbara Pierre's PR 7.06) and tighter than the hurdle finale (Castlin's 7.84 over Vanneisha Ivy's PR 7.93.)
