

### — Eugene Diamond League: SRR Is Back —

Eugene, Oregon; June 1–2—With Olympic fever in the air, American long sprinters Sanya Richards-Ross and Allyson Felix defeated powerhouse fields in the 200 and 400 at the Prefontaine Classic, showing they are ready for the Olympics two months from

now.

Coming off a subpar '11 season, the 27-year-old Richards-Ross ran a strong final straight to pull away from the reigning world champion, Amantle Montsho of Botswana, and Jamaica's Novlene Williams-Mills, who had upset the Jamaican-born SRR in Kings-

ton a month ago.

"The win means a lot to me," Richards-Ross said. "I stayed patient and had the best kick, so I'm happy."

Her 49.39 was the yearly world leader and her fastest in three years, while Montsho (49.62), Williams-Mills (49.78) and Francena McCorory (50.41) and Deedee Trotter (50.80) all ran seasonal bests.

"To perform here is very important," Richards-Ross said of her first-ever win at the meet. "I am glad I was able to pull it off."

Felix, 26, making her seasonal 200 debut, powered away from training partner Jeneba Tarmoh, who ran a great curve in lane 7. The 3-time world champ then shut it down with 25 meters left but still ran 22.23, her fastest since July '10.

"I'm excited," Felix said. "I love this race, I love this crowd."

Tarmoh continued an excellent season, running 22.61 for 2<sup>nd</sup>. Top-rated 100 sprinter Carmelita Jeter, pinched between Felix and Tarmoh in lane 6, was never in it and finished 5<sup>th</sup> in 22.78.

Despite all their other successes, Felix and Richards-Ross, the regal queens of American sprinting for nearly a decade, have never won an individual Olympic gold medal.

With the 200 runners in their blocks, the Hayward Field crowd of 12,845 was still buzzing over the men's high hurdles half an hour earlier, won by China's Liu Xiang in a windy 12.87 (+2.4).

No one has ever run faster, with Liu—the former World Record holder—looking hungry for another Olympic gold to compensate for missing the last Games, on his home soil.

The one hurdler in history who has run a legal 12.87, Dayron Robles, was entered but unable to attend because of visa problems in Cuba.

In his absence, Aries Merritt ran a strong 2<sup>nd</sup> in 12.96w, making him the 10<sup>th</sup> American to go under 13. The American Record holder, David Oliver, was never in contention, running 13.13w for 5<sup>th</sup> and trailing three other Americans—Merritt, Jason Richardson (13.11w) and Dexter Faulk (13.12w).

There was a string of outstanding distance running over a span of 18 hours, which began

with Alysia Montaña opening her 800 season on Friday evening with a stunning 1:57.37, No. 2 in the world this season, and concluded on Saturday with the Kenyan Asbel Kiprop taking the world lead in winning the Bowerman Mile in 3:49.40, a race in which three fine American runners—Bernard Lagat, Lopez Lomong and Andrew Wheating—were the last finishers as a meet record 16 broke 4:00.

The mile produced the 10 fastest in the world for the season, two by 19-year-olds:

Ayanleh Souleiman of Djibouti 3<sup>rd</sup> in 3:50.21, Caleb Ndiku of Kenya 5<sup>th</sup> in 3:50.79.

Mo Farah, trackside from his victory lap in the 5000, yelled encouragement to his fellow Horn native, Souleiman, while not long before Farah was racing alongside his fellow Oregonian, Galen Rupp.

Farah, who runs for the UK but lives in nearby Portland, won with a list-leading 12:56.98. Rupp became the first American to run sub-13:00 on American soil, finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> in a PR 12:58.90, just ahead of Kenenisa

Bekele, the great Ethiopian WR holder.

"I am really happy that my training partner went under 13:00 for the first time," Farah said. "I feel great."

The Friday session included the rare treat of another nation's Olympic selection race—the Kenyan men's 10,000 won by Wilson Kiprop in 27:01.98—a spectacular women's 10K, won by Tirunesh Dibaba in 30:24.39, and an American Record in the women's hammer by Jessica Cosby, who threw 243-5 on her first throw.

"I was in a good rhythm," said Cosby, who also had two other all-time top 5 tosses. "I'm really happy with the result."

### What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is journalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean that the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
