

— NCAA Women: Duncan Powers LSU —

Des Moines, Iowa, June 6–9—For LSU, it was like most years: an NCAA women's team title; for Oregon, it was like the previous three: Wait another year.

Led by rising superstar Kimberly Dun-

can, LSU scored 76 points to Oregon's 62. In eight of the 14 previous editions, 62 would have been enough, and it is the most the Ducks have ever scored.

Three-time defending champ Texas A&M was 3rd (38), and Kansas and Clemson shared

Oregon also thrived in that area—scoring 30—but balance couldn't surmount LSU speed.

Moreover, Oregon soph English Gardner beat Duncan in the 100. Gardner's time—against a 1.7 wind—was 11.10. That equates to 10.98 with no wind.

can, the Tigers exceeded projections to annex their 15th title in 26 years.

The Ducks, who have won the past three indoor titles, finished with a flourish, setting a meet record of 3:24.54 in the 4x4, but were 2nd, as they were in '09, '10 and '11.

They will now have to wait until '13—although that will be back in Eugene—to end a title drought extending to '85.

"You always think you could have done a little better here or done something a little differently there, but in the end, 62 points—the women had a pretty good meet," Oregon coach Vin Lananna said. "LSU just had a better one."

The Tigers, sticking to formula, scored 68 points in the sprints, hurdles and relays. Or-

Gardner also surprisingly led off the 4x4, and Oregon chopped four seconds off the school record to post the No. 2 time in collegiate history. LSU, at 3:24.59, became No. 3.

After lowering her world 200 lead to a low-altitude Collegiate record 22.19 in the semis, Duncan's 22.86 easily won the final into a 2.3 mps wind.

The LSU junior became the first woman

to win NCAA indoor/outdoor 200 doubles in succession.

LSU also had champions in the 4x1 (42.68 CL) and 400 hurdles with Casandra Tate.

"You know, each one is a little bit different, but I can tell you this group truly deserved to win this championship," LSU coach Dennis Shaver said.

"They have done an outstanding job for us the entire outdoor season and have had tremendous focus throughout this 7-day NCAA track meet—3 we had in Jacksonville and then 4 days here."

The Pac-12 led in conference scoring with 187, followed by the SEC with 163. The Big 12 had 132, ACC 53, Missouri Valley 48, Big Ten 47 and Conference USA 43.

Elsewhere:

•Oregon's Brianne Theisen won her third heptathlon, scoring 6440 points for No. 2 on the all-time collegiate list. Barbara Nwaba of UC Santa Barbara was 513 points behind in second. Theisen previously won in '09 and '10.

The NCAA title was her seventh, including three indoor heptathlons and one in the 4x4. Only three women have more: Colette Guidry, Texas, 12; Suziann Reid, Texas, 10; Suzy Favor, Wisconsin, 9.

•The other repeat champions were Arizona high jumper Brigetta Barrett (6-4/1.93) and Oklahoma javelinist Brittany Borman (184-7/56.27).

•Biggest response from the final-day crowd of 6436 was for Des Moines native Katie Flood, a Washington soph who won the 1500 in 4:13.79.

She won 9 state championships and 6 Drake Relays titles while at Dowling Catholic High. She closed in 62.27 to hold off Georgetown's Emily Infeld (4:14.02) and Oregon's Jordan Hasay (4:14.03). Hasay made a late charge at Flood before being nipped at the finish by Infeld.

•On her 19th birthday, Illinois's Ashley Spencer surged down the stretch to win in 50.95 in only her sixth open 400.

She became the first frosh champ since Longhorn Sanya Richards in '03 and first ever from the Big 10. Her 50.95 is No. 5 on the all-time U.S. Junior list and fastest by a

junior worldwide since '08.

She is, however, skipping the Olympic Trials and instead focusing on the USA Junior Championships and next month's Junior worlds in Barcelona.

•Southern Mississippi's Ganna Demydova set a meet record of 46-7¼ (14.20) in a disputed triple jump.

Indoor champ Andrea Geubelle of Kansas thought she had a winning distance of 46-11¾w (14.32). But after talking about her victory in the mixed zone, she learned the jump had been protested and ruled a foul, sending her into tears. She was officially third.

•Stanford's Katerina Stefanidi tied the pole vault meet record of 14-7¼ (4.45).

•Ohio State's Christina Manning completed an indoor/outdoor hurdles sweeping, running the 100 barriers in 12.89 to beat Clemson's Brianna Rollins by 0.02.

DES MOINES, IOWA JUNE 06-09

Once again, the overall national championships was presented by the NCAA as a 2-site system over a 3-week period, with the "preliminaries" being held at East and West sites (see *eTN* 36).

The "heats" and "quarterfinals" of the races and the qualifying rounds in all the field events were held there, with the "semifinals" and finals in Des Moines.
