

— Birmingham DL: Merritt Back On Track —

Birmingham, England, August 26—Four days after an inglorious false start in Lausanne, Aries Merritt reasserted himself as the world's top 110 hurdler at the Aviva Birmingham GP, the 12th stop on the Samsung Diamond League tour.

The 27-year-old Tennessee alum clocked 12.95 to edge out compatriot Jason

Richardson PR-equaling 12.98. Merritt produced his sixth legal sub-13 this year, one shy of the record set by WR holder Dayron Robles in '08. But it was also trip No. 8 under the barrier both legal and windy, an all-time best.

The Olympic 1-2 placers asserted themselves right away as the class of a good field and ran nearly stride-for-stride all the way. Merritt maintained his slight edge off the last barrier to the line.

AR holder David Oliver crashed several hurdles but ran a clear 3rd in 13.28 ahead of Ryan Wilson (13.34).

Before the meet Merritt said, "I think I jumped in Lausanne because I was anxious to try to break the World Record [12.87]. The record is attainable, so I may try for it in Birmingham."

Afterward, he commented, "I made a lot of technical mistakes; I floated a lot of hurdles. Hopefully next time I won't make those mistakes and run a clearer race, then who knows?"

"It's great consistency but I train for this, I work really hard and I put together practice performances that are sub-12.95 so all I need to do is perform like I do in practice. I came pretty close today."

In the 200, Tyson Gay ran his first half-lapper since '10. The '07 world champ got out strong, along with Jamaican Nickel Ashmeade, and the pair ran 1-2 into the homestretch.

Ashmeade edged ahead with about 50 meters to go and took the lead in the closing 10 to win in 20.12 from Gay's 20.21. Wallace Spearmon, drawn on the outside in lane 8, came on strong down the stretch to finish a close 3rd behind Gay with 20.23.

In another back-and-forth high jump duel, following up a scintillating Lausanne competition, Britain's Robbie Grabarz cleared 7-7¼ (2.32) cleanly on his first try to force Olympic winner Ivan Ukhov to pass to 7-8½ (2.35) after a first-jump miss at 2.32.

But the Russian couldn't clear and although Grabarz didn't either, the equal-bronze medalist took the win ahead of Ukhov's 7-5¾ (2.28). Andrey Silnov (also 7-5¾) took 3rd ahead of Lausanne winner

Mutaz Barshim (7-4¼/2.24).

Mo Farah's hoped-for shot at Steve Ovet's 8:13.51 2-mile NR went by the boards from the gun as the double Olympic champ went right to the rear of the pack.

Farah—whose wife had given birth to twin girls only two days before—was content to take over at the bell and clock a 56.5 final lap as he won at will in 8:27.24.

In the top women's race, Carmelita Jeter started well in the 100 versus Olympic champ Shelly-Ann Fraser-Pryce and the Jamaican couldn't quite make up the gap. Jeter prevailed in 10.81 to SAFP's 10.90 as an 0.7mps tailwind pushed the sprinters along.

The 800 time was slow at 2:00.40, but Olympic winner Mariya Savinova took the lead into the final turn as silver medalist and '08 winner Pamela Jelimo was held up in traffic. The Russian split 58.65 for the closing lap to win comfortably from Jelimo's 2:01.43.
