

— 2 More HS Records For Cain —

New York City, January 26—As frenzied as the Armory crowd got on Saturday after Mary Cain had annihilated the national High School Record in the mile (and the 1500 en route to boot), nobody was more excited than the Bronxville, New York, junior herself.

Two weeks after running the fastest prep 3000 ever, Cain clocked a stunning 4:32.78 in the elite women's race at the New Balance Games and was a beaming bundle of energy moments later.

"I knew I could do it, I *knew* I could," she said, beaming, bouncing and clearly reveling in her success. "But actually doing it was amazing."

Cain, who split with her school's team last fall and is now coached remotely by Oregon-based Alberto Salazar, was rumored to be going after Debbie Heald's ancient 4:38.5 standard, set way back in March of '72 in the U.S./USSR dual.

Mixing it up with today's professionals, the 16-year-old Cain ran a smart, savvy race to finish 3rd overall with a time that made a mockery of Heald's mark and is also significantly faster than Polly Plumer's outdoor record, 4:35.24, from '82.

En route she passed though 1500 meters in 4:16.11, considerably faster than Lynn Jennings' '78 HSR (and American Junior Record) of 4:18.9.

Through the first half of the race Cain remained only steps off the lead, splitting 67.3 at the quarter and reaching halfway in 2:16.7. When Sarah Brown (née Bowman) took over

from the rabbit at about 900 meters, Cain was still in contact, but drifting back into the pack.

"With 600 meters to go I was kind of like,

As Canadian Nicole Sifuentes began to challenge Bowman up front, Cain was working her way back towards the front, coming through three-quarters in 3:28.0. At that

point it was as much about racing as it was about going for a record.

"The last 200 I was just gunning it," Cain said. "I'm a kicker and that's what I do."

Brown, the '09 NCAA champ for Tennessee who finally seems to be over the injuries that plagued her the last two years, barely held off Sifuentes' charge, 4:31.61–4:31.65, then shared a victory lap with Cain.

Cain, who took her SATs earlier in the day, says she tries not to focus on setting records. "I don't want to get psyched out or freak out with it," she explained, but admitted that her 3000 record in Seattle on January 12 was a sign that she was in shape to do something special.

"I just stay calm throughout the whole experience, then when you cross the line it's like, [you see] it's the record! That's the cherry on top for me."

Next up for Cain, is the 2-mile at Boston's New Balance Indoor Grand Prix on February 2, followed by a return to the Armory on February 16 for the Millrose Games mile.

The Armory is now the site of both the boys and girls prep marks. Alan Webb ran his historic 3:59.86 there in '01.
