

— The 106th Millrose: A Recordfest —

New York City, February 16—The 106th Millrose Games was a frantic rush of record-setting performances, dominated (once again) by Bernard Lagat, who picked up his 10th win at the iconic meet in a dominating performance over 2 miles.

Hammering the final two laps of Armory's accommodating oval, he snatched back the American Record he desperately wanted, clocking 8:09.49.

After a slower-than-desired opening mile of 4:05.9 (Lagat 4:06.2) rabbit Haron Lagat stepped aside and left Lagat up front to pursue his target: Galen Rupp's 8:09.72 from last year (which had taken down Lagat's 8:10.07 from '11).

In addition to the clock, the 38-year-old icon had hungry youngsters Evan Jager, Cam Levins and Andrew Bumbalough to contend with.

At the mile-and-a-half mark Lagat still led, with a smooth Jager looking ready to pounce. The pressure only seemed to motivate Lagat, who began to open up on the steeplechaser as they hit two laps to go.

He powered through a 30.32, then a 28.82 to finish just ahead of Rupp's mark, in 8:09.49.

Jager (8:14.95) faded to 4th, as Bumbalough (8:13.02) and Levins (8:14.69 Canadian Record) passed him in the final 400.

Lagat, who won 8 Millrose mile titles before taking the 5000 last year, says he was focused only on the clock.

"I was more concerned

about getting the time than in winning," he said, "because when it comes down to the last two laps, 400 meters, I [knew I] was going to hold off anybody."

A lap behind, Edward Cheserek of St. Benedict's Prep in Newark ran a mostly solo effort to finish eighth in 8:39.15 and break

Gerry Lindgren's legendary High School Record of 8:40.0, which had celebrated its 49th (!) anniversary just a day earlier.

Joining Lagat in the American Record column were Alysia Montaño and Erik Sowinski in their 600-meter runs.

Montaño, who had previously said running on small indoor tracks was a painful experience, charged right to the front and split 26.50 and 54.38 for the first two laps en route to a 1:23.59.

That obliterated Delisa Walton-Floyd's '81 standard (1:26.56) and nearly caught Russian Olga Kotlyarova's '04 world mark of 1:23.44.

"This track is amazing," said a converted Montaño. "I loved it. My body feels good. I can see myself here again. I'm kind of addicted."

Sowinski, last year's NCAA outdoor 800 runner-up for Iowa and an Olympic Trials semifinalist, crashed the party that had been billed as a Duane Solomon/Nick Symmonds match race.

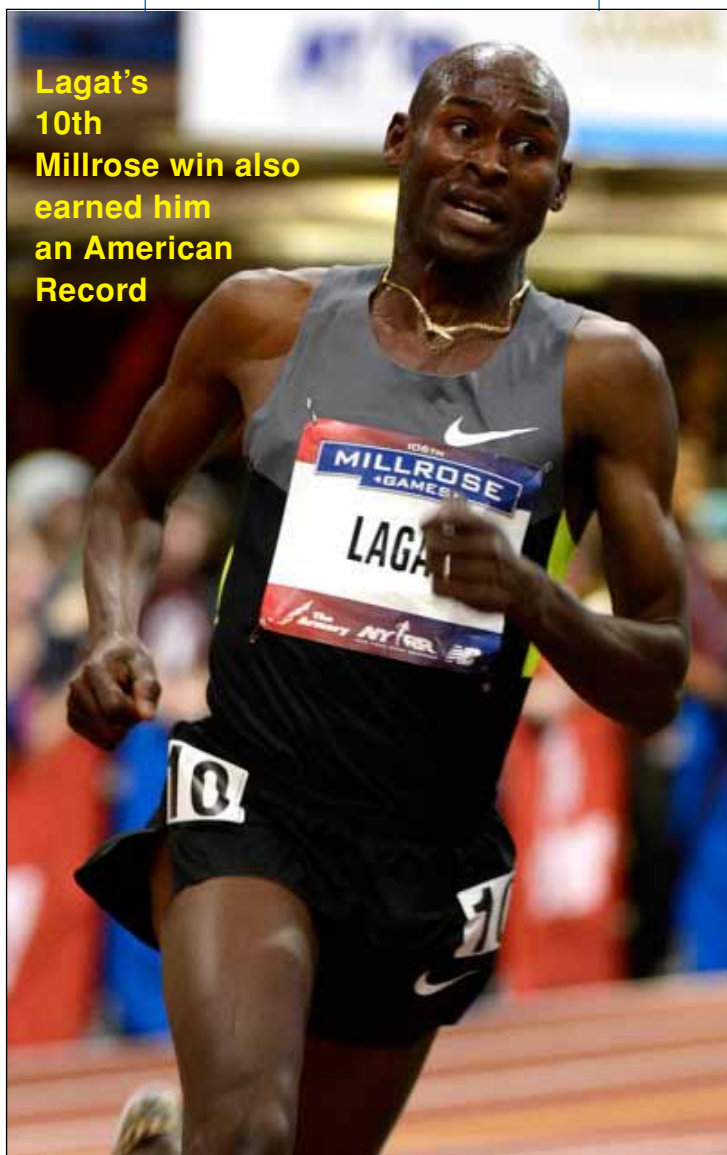
Solomon set a strong early tempo (23.25, 48.38) in an attempt to lower the 1:15.70 AR he set last month in Glasgow, with (unrelated) Jarrin Solomon close behind.

Sowinski—a last-minute replacement for Belgian 400 star Kevin Borlée—came charging off the final turn to take the win in 1:15.61, closing in 26.86.

Duane Solomon held 2nd at 1:16.04, while a predictably fast-closing Symmonds (1:16.89) took 4th but was never a factor.

Symmonds said of Sowinski, "I remember him

from my semi at the Olympic Trials and I thought, 'This is a kid to watch out for.'

Mary Cain continued her rampage through the high school recordbooks, smashing her own mile record with a 4:28.25 to finish 2nd in a women's field filled with top collegiate and pro runners.

The time made her the No. 6 American of any age indoors and cuts the 4:32.78 she ran at the Armory three weeks earlier.

Cain double-dipped into the recordbooks with a 4:11.72 at 1500 meters en route, erasing the 4:16.11 split from her previous record.

Canadian Sheila Reid scorched the last two laps to win in 4:27.02, but it was the Alberto Salazar-coached phenom's gumption and electric finish that really energized the crowd.

The men's mile, always the signature event of Millrose, closed out the meet with a dazzling homestretch duel between Lopez Lomong and Matthew Centrowitz. Lomong (3:51.21) broke Lagat's meet record (3:52.87 on Madison Square Garden's smaller oval in '05) to hold off Centro (3:51.34) and four others under 3:55.

Lomong and Centrowitz moved to Nos. 3 & 4 on the all-time list U.S. while 4th-placer Chris O'Hare of Tulsa (by way of Edinburgh) broke the Collegiate Record in 3:52.98 (and also got the 1500 mark in 3:37.25).

Giving Lagat some company in the senior citizen department, 35-year-old Doc Patton scored a dominating 6.50 win in the 60, a full 0.14 ahead of Gerald Phiri.

"This may be my last year," he said after his world-leading mark, "I want to go out with a bang."

What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is journalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean that the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
