

### — NCAA Indoor Men: #20 For Hogs —

Fayetteville, Arkansas, March 08–09—Arkansas showed the ultimate in team performance, displaying top-end strength (3 wins), depth (13 individuals and 1 relay scoring) and breadth (scoring in 11 events).

This was the first NCAA championship for head coach Chris Bucknam, and the first Arkansas title since '06. The school's indoor total is now at 20, and the in/out/XC tally is 41.

The Razorbacks' 74 points were the most since '94 when Arkansas scored a meet record 94.

Arkansas's depth was so great that it overcame a near-perfect Florida team that scored 59 points while virtually maximizing its opportunities. But not all was smooth for the hosts.

On the first day, the wheels appeared to be falling off in the heats, as the top seed in the 800 and third seed in the hurdles failed to advance. And when the distance medley anchor had the baton knocked from his hand and failed to score, it looked like Arkansas might be falling back to the pack.

Field events came through big on the first day, however. Andrew Irwin won one of the great NCAA indoor vaults ever, his 18-8½ (5.70) giving the Hog soph his second indoor title.

Long jumpers Raymond Higgs and Jarriion Lawson took 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> for 11 more points, and heptathlete Kevin Lazas had a

98-point at the end of the first day.

On the second day, Lazas barely held on through a stumbling struggle over the last 10 meters of the heptathlon 1000, winning by 10 points with a 6175 total.

High jumper Anthony May scraped through with an 8<sup>th</sup> amidst one of the great high jump competitions ever, as Indiana's Olympic bronze medalist Derek Drouin won at a Candian Record 7-8½ (2.35), with close misses at a Collegiate Record 7-9¾ (2.38). Kansas State's Olympic silver medalist Erik Kynard finished 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7-6 (2.29), with seven jumpers clearing 7-5 (2.26).

Triple jumper Tarik Batchelor added a 3<sup>rd</sup> and medley anchor Kemoy Campbell a 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 3000, before the Hog 4x4 closed out the meet with a wire-to-wire win in Collegiate Record time, 3:03.50.

Said Bucknam, "To get this done, you need a special group of athletes. The coaching staff had everything in place. I'm really proud of how these guys got it together. We followed the plan, and we came in here and got it done. We just hope our alumni are proud. We look at all the national championship banners in the ceiling, and our number one goal was to make them proud and show them that we were back. With the 4x400-meter relay, we just wanted to finish it off right, and we got that collegiate record this time."

## What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is jounalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean tha the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
