

### — NCAA Women: 4 In A Row For Ducks —

Fayetteville, Arkansas, March 08–09— Oregon had a near-perfect NCAA Championships, dominating the running events for all of their 56 points and giving the Ducks a fourth straight title.

Kansas, which dominated in the field with wins by Andrea Geubelle in the long and triple jumps and Natalia Bartnovskaya in the pole vault, scored 44, with LSU (43) and Arkansas (42½) trailing.

Oregon managed only one victory, its 4x4 title coming out of the lowest seeded of the three sections in the event. The time of 3:30.22 was more than ample against a field which included the remaining pretenders for the team crown.

Jordan Hasay stayed away from the distance medley for the first time in this meet, as she tried for maximum points with a 5000/3000 double.

Despite looking tired the first day while finishing 4<sup>th</sup> in 15:40.30, she came back strong to take 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 3000 with a 9:06.61.

In both instances the winner was Dartmouth junior Abbey D'Agostino, whose strong moves found her winning each race by about five-and-a-half seconds with times of 15:28.11 and 9:01.08. This was the first 3/5 double win since Sally Kipyego in '07.

Oregon's relay anchor was Laura Roesler, who had finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 800 with a behind LSU's Natoya Goule, who won in

2:02.00. Lead-off runner English Gardner had finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 60 with 7.15, just 0.02 behind winner Aurieyall Scott. Scott

was the runner-up in the 200 to the NCAA's first three-time champion in the event, LSU's 2012 Bowerman Award recipient Kimberly Duncan, who ran 22.58.

Oklahoma putter Tia Brooks set a Collegiate Record 63-¾ (19.22) to win her second straight title, while Clemson's Brianna Rollins set a pair of meet records in the hurdles, with a 7.82 in the heats and a 7.79 final, missing her CR by just 0.01.

"All we could do today was control 'Oregon,'" said Duck head Robert Johnson. "We were the captain of our own fate.

"A tip of the hat to the way all of our Ducks not only came out and competed today, but also supported and cheered each other on. This was an outstanding team effort."

## What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is jounalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean tha the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
