

— World XC: Usual Suspects + U.S. Shock —

Bydgoszcz, Poland, March 24—It was here three years ago that the renaissance of U.S. harriers can arguably have said to have begun as the women's team took a surprise set of bronze medals.

This year, the men got in on the act—and upped the ante a notch—as they took the team silver, the first time they had been on

the podium since '01.

Individually, there was no stopping the latest Kenyan discovery Japhet Korir as the teenager became the youngest ever Senior Men's champion, sprinting away from Ethiopia's defending champion Imane Merga with 500 meters remaining in the 12K race, winning in 32:45 on a day when the temperatures never getting over freezing.

Behind the leading pair of East Africans, Dartmouth alum Ben True was having the race of his life.

True, with three national titles on the roads to his name, stayed off the back of the leading pack during the first of six 2K laps, moved up to 11th by the halfway point and then came through solidly over the final 3K to finish 6th, crossing the line in 33:11 for the best individual U.S. performance at these Championships since Pat Porter finished 4th in '84.

His teammates were in great form as well. Chris Derrick was 10th (33:23), Ryan Vail 17th (33:42) and Bobby Mack 18th (33:49) to complete the scoring quartet and, stun a selection of African teams, by coming home 2nd behind Ethiopia, which managed to usurp Kenya from the top slot for only the third time since '86.

Ethiopia also added the Junior men's title thanks to the hugely impressive Hagos Gebrhiwet, who had set a World Junior indoor 3000 record of 7:32.87 in Boston at the start of last month and ran a World Junior 5000 record of 12:47.53 at the Samsung Diamond League meet in Paris last summer.

Gebrhiwet covered the 8K course in a blistering 21:04. The top American was Purdue's Matt McClintock in 20th (22:52) and led the U.S. to an outstanding 4th.

The U.S. women, after team bronzes at the last two Championships in '10 & '11—the event

is now being held every two years—had hope of a hat trick but just finished out of the medals on this occasion in 4th.

Kenya's Emily Chebet clearly has an affinity for Bydgoszcz as she regained the title she won three years ago by closing down Ethiopia's Hiwet Ayalew on the last lap, her rival hearing the bell with a 6-second advantage, and then sprinting away as the pair descended a steep hill with 200 to go.

Chebet finished in 24:24 with Neely Spence Gracey being the best non-African born runner in 13th place with 25:08.

Deena Kastor, now 40 and the winner of a brace of silver medals under her maiden name of Drossin in '02 and '03, was the oldest woman of the 97 on the start line but was the fourth U.S. scorer in 34th.

The first title of the day went to Kenya's Faith Kipyegon in the Junior Women's race, the 19-year-old World Junior Champs 1500 gold medalist dominating over the final kilo of the 4K race to beat her compatriot Agnes Tirop and retain the title she won in Spain two years ago.

The results gave the pair the same time of 17:51 but there was definitely a few meters difference between the pair at the line. Colorado frosh Carrie Vernon led home the U.S. team, which finished 6th, when in 20th in 19:33.

What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is journalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean tha the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
