

— Team USA Dominates At Penn Again —

Philadelphia, April 25–27—“This is sensational; this is a fantastic event,” gushed first-time Penn Relays attendee Sebastian Coe.

“It’s unique in the world, the whole scene is incredible,” cooed the mile legend, gazing around Franklin Field, packed with 48,871 screaming, ooh-and-aaing, flag-waving enthusiasts of all the track & field arts, who brought the 3-day attendance total at the 119th edition to 111,824.

The architect of the ultra-successful London Olympics had plenty to gush over. Saturday at the Penn Relays had always been a huge Philly happening—but the coming of the USA Vs. The World series at the turn of the century simply made it bigger, better, noisier—and, of course, faster.

So it was again.

2013’s bottom line read Team USA 4, Jamaica 1, Ethiopia 1.

America’s men won the 4x1 (38.26) and 4x4 (3:00.91), the women the 4x4 (3:22.26) and 4x8 (with a national-record demolishing 8:04.31).

Jamaica’s women sped off with the 4x1 (42.42) and Ethiopia’s men the DMR (9:16.34)

“I start the year like I never won anything,” said mega-medaled Shelly-Ann Fraser-Pryce of Jamaica after anchoring the 4x1.

She continues calling herself “a hungry athlete,” and with that kind of voracity, the Beijing and London titlist’s dream of a record third straight Olympic 100 title remains solidly on track.

In the absence of injured Carmelita Jeter, USA Blue’s Porscha Lewis and USA Red’s Jeneba Tarmoh gave valiant Penn chase, but were never close.

Manteo Mitchell’s appetite may even ex-

ceed SAFP’s.

The left fibula he broke running the 4x4 heats at London has clearly been rehabbed to full strength and velocity. His 44.8 second-leg carry was key to USA Red’s 4x4 verdict over Jamaica (3:01.15) and London champion Bahamas (3:02.23), with Tony McQuay delivering an identical 44.8 on anchor.

“Before I got into track & field, I always wanted to inspire a generation,” Mitchell tells you—and he’s doing just that right now.

Lea Wallace (2:02.0), Brenda Martinez (2:03.1), 18-year-old Ajee’ Wilson (a strategic 2:03.1) kept USA in front before Alysia Montano’s sizzling 1:58.6 turned the 4x8 into a rout. Smashed to bits was the Tennessee 8:17.91 that had stood as the American record since ’09.

The Tennessee mark was doubly destroyed when Emily Lipari-anchored Villanova took the college 4x8 in a CR 8:17.45. “I can’t believe it,” said coach Gina Procaccio. “I just can’t stop smiling.”

The 119th Penns drew 221 American col-

leges—plus guest schools from Jamaica and Puerto Rico—but it was Texas A&M playing the dominator. With 12 Penn watch-winning performances, Coach Pat Henry’s Aggies reigned. “This has been the best effort from a team I’ve had at this meet in a long, long time,” said Henry. “This team definitely left a mark.”

The top individual mark of the meet was Indiana leaper Derek Drouin’s 7-7¼ (2.33) clearance in the high jump. It erased Dwight Stones’s then-WR of 7-7¼ (2.32) from ’76 as a Relays and Franklin Field record. And broadcaster Stones was the first to text his congratulations

What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is journalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean tha the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
