

— Doha Kicks Off Diamond League Nicely —

Doha, Qatar, May 10—Through the first two rounds of the women's long jump in the season-opening Diamond League meet, the scorecard read: wind 2–Brittney Reese 0.

As in zero marks, thanks to two fouls.

But the reigning world and Olympic champion has been down to a final attempt to remain in the competition before so she didn't panic. She made the appropriate adjustment to the conditions and got off a wind-aided third jump of 23-1¼ (7.04) to pull into 2nd behind Nigeria's Blessing Okagbare, who seemed destined for victory after her slightly-wind-aided 23-5¼ (7.14) in round 2.

On her very next attempt, Reese exploded off the board and soared out to 23-9½ (7.25). A quick check of the gauge returned a legal reading of 1.6mps, and when Okagbare had no answer, Reese walked away with a victory, a new PR, the yearly world lead, and the best jump by an American since '98, improving her hold on No. 3 on the all-time U.S. list.

"The wind started off really rough for everybody," Reese said of the first two rounds, which had produced 13 fouls. "Once I got adjusted and figured out what it was going to do, I was going to have to approach it real confident. My fouls were around 7.25 so I knew that once I got on the board I was going to be able to pop a big one

out."

What was even more remarkable was that she did not employ a full run-up, something she will employ at the Diamond League's

so I knew that coming in I was bound to get one. I just had to go out and get it."

The 26-year-old Ole Miss alum is targeting the American Record of 24-7 (7.47) set in '94 by Jackie Joyner-Kersey, and feels it is attainable after this performance.

"To come out here and hit 7.25 off a three-quarter approach is remarkable because I am chasing an American Record," she said. "To be where I am right now, I feel like I am on schedule."

Reese's jump was part of a nice showing by U.S. athletes, who accounted for 6 victories and 3 world leads.

In the men's shot, Ryan Whiting rebounded from a season-opening loss to Reese Hoffa at the Drake Relays with a monster fifth-round throw measuring 73-1¼ (22.28), good for a PR and meet record in addition to the WL.

The mark moved the Arizona State alum into the No. 7 spot on the all-time U.S. list.

"In college, I was in shape to throw about that so it has definitely been a while," the third-year pro said. "I had good practices this week and I kind of knew something was in there. I just needed to relax and get it

out. I've learned that you can't really force big throws. You just have to let it happen."

In the women's straightaway hurdles, Dawn Harper-Nelson lowered her world-lead to 12.60 while turning back fellow Americans Kellie Wells (12.73), Queen Har-

She came into this competition extremely confident based on what she has seen in practice. "I have most definitely had indicators that this was coming," she explained. "I've been jumping 7 meters [23ft] off of 10 steps

rierson (12.74), and Lolo Jones (12.97).

In the men's triple jump, Olympic champion Christian Taylor used a final-round hop, skip and jump of 56-7¼ (17.25) to leapfrog France's Benjamin Compaoré for the win. Taylor, like Reese, has yet to break out his full approach to the board.

In the men's 400 hurdles, Michael Tinsley capitalized on a late mistake by Bershawn Jackson, who clipped the final barrier, to score a narrow 48.92-49.12 victory with his second sub-49 of the year.

The men's 100 saw Olympic bronze medalist Justin Gatlin dip slightly at the line to pick up a narrow victory in 9.97 over U.S. teammate Mike Rodgers and Jamaica's Nesta Carter, both of whom clocked 9.99.
