

### — SAFP Wins Big Shanghai DL 100 Clash —

Shanghai, China, May 18—In a match-up of the winners of the last two major women's 100 titles, 2-time Olympic champion Shelly-Ann Fraser-Pryce again proved her big-race mettle as the diminutive Jamaican outran reigning world titlist Carmelita Jeter at the Golden Grand Prix, the second stop on the IAAF Diamond League tour.

Fraser-Pryce led from the gun to power to a world-pacing 10.93 and comfortably turn back Nigeria's Blessing Okagbare (11.00). Jeter, meanwhile, got out behind SAFP and barely held 2<sup>nd</sup> in the late going as Okagbare surged.

Before the race, Fraser-Pryce said, "All the women sprinters have been in the same time region, except Carmelita. She ran 10.64 [in Shanghai in '09] and for me, that's where I want to go. She raised the game for all of us. I want to step up a notch."

Jeter—who had suffered a hamstring cramp at Mt. SAC a month ago—suddenly clutched at her right quad in the final meters, held on for 3<sup>rd</sup> in 11.08 and was stretched off the track in obvious distress.

Stepping up and out ahead of the 400 field, Worlds/Olympic winner Kirani James showed his superiority in no uncertain terms. The Grenadan got up on the shoulder of '08 Games champ LaShawn Merritt just after 200, smoothly worked the third 100 and carried a 3-meter lead ahead of Merritt and London silver winner Luguélin Santos into the stretch.

But catching the long-striding James wasn't in the cards on this night as he cruised 44.02 to chop a big 0.70 off his mid-April world leader. Merritt followed at a U.S.-pacing 44.60 with Santos (45.11) a well-back 3<sup>rd</sup>.

James's time matched the fastest-ever for the month of May, although Michael Johnson ran 43.75 in mid-April of '97 for the fastest 1-lapper so early in an outdoor season.

Just as Jeter suffered leg miseries, so did hurdle star Aries Merritt. The Olympic champ and WR holder got only three strides out of the blocks before he stopped, gingerly treading on his right leg.

London silver medalist Jason Richardson led from the gun to win in 13.23, a U.S. leader and 0.02 ahead of a hard-charging Ryan Wilson. The veteran American edged the 13.28 PR by China's Wenjun Xie.

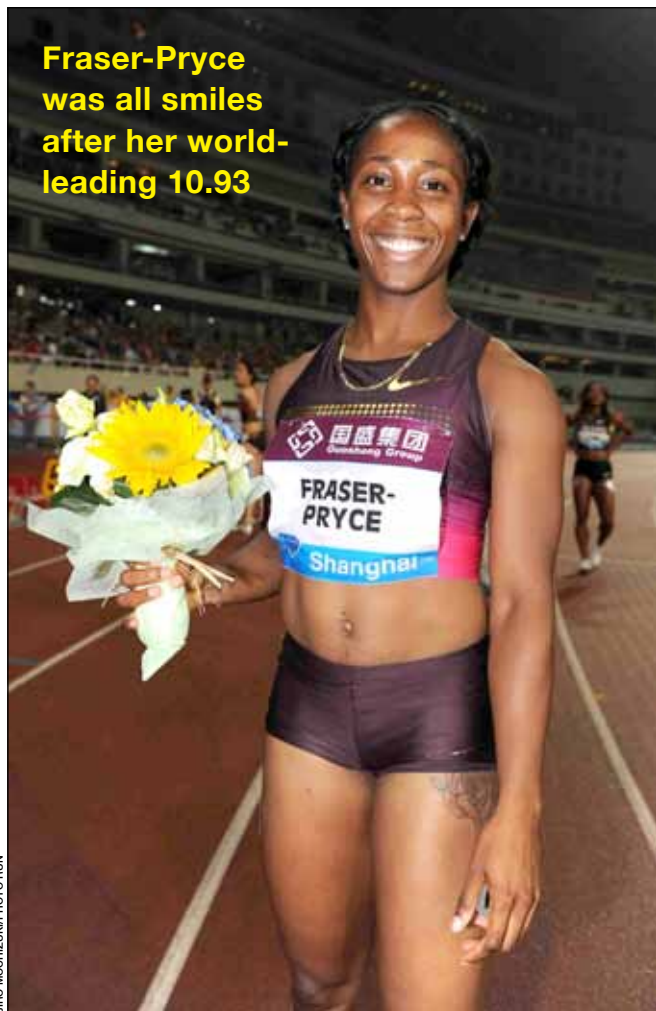
A spacked long jump field that included the last three Olympic champions (Greg Rutherford, Irving Saladino & Dwight Phillips), as well as Games medalists Khotso Mokoena, Mitchell Watt and Will Claye—was upstaged by China's Jinzhe Li.

The 23-year-old, who didn't get out of the London Q round, rode a 1.1mps wind on his fourth attempt to span a PR 27-4½ (8.34). He then watched anxiously as Euro champ Aleksandr Menkov took his final two leaps.

The Russian came close on his final effort, but fell just short at 27-3¼ (8.31), still a career-long. Rutherford (26-6¼/8.08) followed in 3<sup>rd</sup>, but the other big-namers trailed. Phillips in 10<sup>th</sup> (25-0/7.62) was in his first competition since mid-September of '11 after missing all last season due to an Achilles tendon injury.

In the men's steeple, young Kenyan Coneslus Kipruto clocked a year-leading

8:01.16 to edged veteran countryman Paul Koech (8:02.63) and cement his hold on No. 2 Junior ever.

In the women's vault, Yelena Isinbaeva topped 15-5 (4.70) on her second try to win her first competition since taking the Olympic bronze in London. She then tried 15-11 (4.85) twice but ran through both attempts. On the second, she stopped before the box, sat on the pit and massaged her left Achilles and later applied ice to the aching tendon.

## What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is journalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean that the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
