

— Tough Conditions For New York DL —

Randalls Island, New York, May 25—You know what they say about New York: If you can make it here, you can make it anywhere.

Given the horrible conditions during the adidas Grand Prix, that should be especially true for athletes during the remainder of the Diamond League season.

Despite temperatures in the low 50s—with rain and squally winds—several marquee stars came to the newly resurfaced Icahn Stadium track and showed that they could handle whatever the Big Apple (or Mother Nature) could throw at them.

Blanka Vlašić was the meet's most pleasant surprise, returning to competition for the first time since September 2011 following surgery to repair her Achilles and a subsequent bacterial infection that sidelined the two-time world champion for the entire Olympic season.

Swathed in a fuchsia blanket during warmups and in between attempts, track & field's dancing diva looked smooth as she made her way through the first six heights—from 5-8¾ (1.75) to 6-4¼ (1.94)—with a clean card. At that point she had the competition won, with Emma Green Tregaro edging Brigetta Barrett (who flew into New York that morning following a late-night of qualifying at the NCAA West regional in Austin) for second, both clearing 6-3¼ (1.91).

Though Vlašić failed to get over 6-5 ½ (1.97), the lanky Croatian could not have been happier—or more relieved. "I cannot explain to you how scared I was before this competition," she said, admitting that she still feels pain when jumping.

"I came here I didn't know if I'm ready or not. It's a dream come true to come back and win my first competition, under these

circumstances. I'm just happy I'm not home watching on TV anymore."

A year ago Tyson Gay was in the same spot as Vlašić, using the New York meet as a critical post-injury test. He won the B section of the 100 in '12 and topped that this year with a comfortable victory in the headline race.

Into a -0.8 wind the 2007 world champ clocked 10.02, well ahead of Ryan Bailey (10.15).

"My start was a bit sluggish," Gay said, though he was pleased with his time and how his body handled running the final less than an hour and a half after the heats. "I missed some practice time after the 200 in Clermont [a windy 19.79 on May 11] because my groin was sore. When I miss start practices I tend to go back to old habits, but I will tighten that up."

Perhaps Vlašić and Gay's recoveries will help motivate Sanya Richards-Ross, who scratched from the 400 barely an hour before race time, still fighting to recover from toe surgery last September.

"I'm so sorry I wasn't able to compete today," she tweeted of what was to be her long delayed and much anticipated season opener. "I want to be back on the track more than anything

but my foot isn't ready. It's tough. As an athlete it's always difficult to know when to push it and when to be patient. It's a long season and I want to be ready for Worlds."

In the Olympic champion's absence Botswana's Amantle Montsho won her second straight Diamond League race of the season,

a surprisingly fast (for the conditions) 49.91. Behind her Natasha Hastings closed well for second in 50.24, the Brooklyn native's fastest time since '07.

David Rudisha produced another effortless victory in the 800, coasting to 1:45.15, a far cry from the U.S. all-comers record 1:41.74 he blasted at this meet last year.

"It was cold, and there was a strong wind and it is difficult to run under those conditions," the typically soft-spoken Kenyan said after finishing more than a second ahead of Brit Andrew Osagie (1:46.44). "I tried my best, but I was expecting to do something better."

And while Vlašić may have grabbed more headlines, she probably wasn't even the meet's top Croatia performer. Hours before the main program began, in conditions so hateful that a 45-minute break was taken in between the first and second rounds, Olympic champ Sandra Perković whipped out three meet records in the discus, including a fifth-round 224-8 (68.48) that improved her own world lead.

Not every field event was able to escape the consequences of the weather, with the men's triple jump and women's pole vault particularly adversely affected. Frances Benjamin Compaoré won the beleaguered triple (contested during the afternoon's nastiest bout of rain and wind) with a paltry 53-11 $\frac{3}{4}$ (16.45), holding off Christian Taylor's 53-10 $\frac{1}{2}$ (16.42).

Taylor's fellow Olympic champ Jenn Suhr managed to win her event, but looked shaky in clearing only 15-2 $\frac{1}{4}$ (4.63) in the vault.

What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is journalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean tha the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
