

— NCAA Men: A Last-Minute Tie —

Eugene, Oregon, June 5–8—Is there any better way to decide a meet than by the competition-concluding 4 x 400? How about when the NCAA team title is on the line with the relay's outcome?

Fans in TrackTown USA—11,482 in Hayward Field on the final Saturday to cap a four-day total of 40,446—got such a climax at the 92nd edition of the college championships.

No doubt some of them may have talked of the dramatic scenario—but highly unlikely, right?—that for Texas A&M to not be the thick of the title fight, it would have to finish last in the 4x4.

The Aggies had amassed 52 points going into the 4x4 and ran the fastest time of the year with a 3:02.38 prelim.

Hot on the Texans' heels would be team defender Florida, second-quickest in the semis at 3:02.64 but trailing in the team tussle at 43.

So what happened? A&M leadoff Ricky Babineaux dropped the stick before he got it to No. 2 Aldrich Bailey. But Babineaux coolly retrieved the stick himself and thus avoided a DQ.

The Aggies were in a far-back 8th, however, while the relay-defending Gators led all the way to win in 3:01.34, capped by a 44.87 anchor from frosh Arman Hall.

A&M came home in 3:07.64 to earn a single point and make its total 53, while Florida's winning 10 boosted UF to 53 and—voilà—a tie. It was the first deadlock for the team victory since UCLA and UTEP knotted in '78 in—where else?—Eugene.

"When you look at the recordbook 20

years from now, it will say 'Florida' next to 'NCAA champion,'" said UF head man Mike Holloway. "We're very pleased and proud."

Pat Henry said A&M was proud of a fourth title in the last five years and allowed that while the way Title No. 4 was won

In a tight three-way fight for 3rd, Indoor winner Arkansas scored 46½ to edge Oregon (44) and USC (42) even though no Razorback won an individual event.

The Oregon faithful raised the roof two days in a row when Elijah Greer first won the 800 on Friday at 1:46.58. Then on Saturday,

was heart-breaking, "We're still national champions."

Both schools got major contributions from individual winners: Ameer Webb (200), Wayne Davis (110H) and Sam Humphreys (JT) for A&M; the 4x1 and TJ defender Omar Craddock for Florida.

Mac Fleet completed a comeback after a foot injury kept him out of action for 22 months. His 1500 winner timed only 3:50.25 but a 52.21 final lap capped his triumph as the Duck fans went berserk.

USC got a magic win of its own as Bryshon Nellum took the 400 at 44.73 to

write a victorious end to his own long return from being shot five years ago and then struggling with subsequent leg miseries. He also ran 3rd in the 200 (20.27w).

The Trojans got another one-lap win from 400H champion Reggie Wyatt (48.58).

The lone double victor was Arizona junior Lawi Lalang, who first took the 10,000 by 12 seconds with 29:29.65.

Two days later, the lanky Kenyan completed the pair with a 13:35.19 to claim the 5000 by more than 5.0.

In a stellar clash of Olympic medalists, Indiana's Canadian senior and Olympic bronze winner Derek Drouin high jumped 7-8 (2.34) to top Kansas State's Erik Kynard, the London silver medalist, who made 7-7 (2.31).

It was Drouin's fifth career title and his second outdoors—the other coming in Eugene in '10. Drouin is now 8-6 in career meetings versus Kynard.

The apron at Hayward obviously agrees with the jumpers as they placed 2nd (Kynard) and 3rd (Drouin) at the Pre Classic the weekend before the NCAA, both clearing PRs of 7-8¾ (2.36).

EUGENE, OREGON JUNE 05–08

Once again, the overall national championships was presented by the NCAA as a 2-site system over a 3-week period, with the "preliminaries" being held at East and West sites (see *eTN* 35).

The "heats" and "quarterfinals" of the races and the qualifying rounds in all the field events were held there, with the "semifinals" and finals in Eugene.

All four days were warm & sunny (first 3 days/evenings high of 84/29C, last day high of 82/28C); frequently breezy.
