

### — NCAA Women: A First For Kansas —

Eugene, Oregon, June 5–8—Yes, Dorothy & Toto, the NCAA women's team title *is* in Kansas—for the first time.

Stanley Redwine's Jayhawks squad relied

coach, said, "Yes, we had the field strength, but we also have a balanced team. We have great coaches and athletes who all work together very well."

It was assistant Wayne Pate who provided

hurdles. First in the 100H heats, Clemson junior Brianna Rollins skipped to a 12.47 clocking (wind +1.2mps) to clip 0.01 off the '06 mark run by USC's Ginnie Crawford.

Then, Stanford junior Kori Carter cruised

on field event strength to claim their initial team championship as their 60 points put them comfortably ahead of Texas A&M (44). KU's field power alone accumulated 48, enough by itself to secure the title.

As it was, KU had only a single individual winner, heptathlete Lindsay Vollmer (a PR 6086). But the Jayhawks got points out of 10 other athletes, including LJ/TJ runner-up Andrea Geubelle and vault 2<sup>nd</sup>-placer Natalia Bartnovskaya.

Redwine, in his 13<sup>th</sup> season as KU head

both perspective and a spark after Kansas placed 2<sup>nd</sup> at this winter's NCAA Indoor. Explained Geubelle, "Coach Pate stood up and told us it was a 3-month commitment. That's all it took.

"If we just went out and worked as hard as we could every single day, [then] going into nationals we would have confidence that I don't think any other schools knew we had. And a lot of that came from our coaching staff."

Two Collegiate Records fell, both in the

53.21 to claim the 400H victory and better the 53.54 run in '04 by UCLA's Sheena Tosta. Carter turned back the 53.72 PR by arch-rival Georganne Moline of Arizona.

Finally in the 100H final, Rollins was even faster as she rolled to a 12.39 (+1.7mps wind) to move to No. 4 American all-time. She turned back the 12.79 by Carter, who became only the third hurdler in meet history to score a win and a 2<sup>nd</sup> over the barriers.

Half-a-dozen winners from last year repeated this time. All three sprint champs

retained their titles: English Gardner (Oregon) with a 10.96 PR in the 100; Kimberlyn Duncan (LSU) with a wind-aided 22.04, matching the fastest 200 in meet history; and, Ashley Spencer (Illinois) with a 400 PR of 50.28.

Gardner tweaked a sore right ankle in her 200 heat and didn't advance to the half-lap final, thus hurting Oregon's chances to complete a cross country/indoor/outdoor triple crown. She was healthy enough to handle the second leg on UO's 4<sup>th</sup>-place 4x1, then announced shortly after that she will turn pro.

Other successful defenders included Dartmouth's Abbey D'Agostino in the 5000 (15:43.68), with Oregon's Jordan Hasay 3<sup>rd</sup> in her final try to win an outdoor individual event, and CR-setters Brigetta Barrett (Arizona) in the high jump (6-4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>/1.95) and Oklahoma putter Tia Brooks (62-1/2/18.91).

Colorado senior Emma Coburn led the steeplechase all the way to win in 9:35.38 and regain the title she won in '11. She redshirted the '12 season to prepare for the Olympics.

## EUGENE, OREGON JUNE 05-08

Once again, the overall national championships was presented by the NCAA as a 2-site system over a 3-week period, with the "preliminaries" being held at East and West sites (see e7N 36).

The "heats" and "quarterfinals" of the races and the qualifying rounds in all the field events were held there, with the "semifinals" and finals in Eugene.

### What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is jounalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean tha the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
