

### — The Oslo DL Sees The Real Bolt —

Oslo, Norway, June 13—After saying that he didn't like running in the cold, Usain Bolt didn't seem to be slowed down by the chilly conditions for the ExxonMobil Bislett Games 200.

The WR holder produced the only meet record of the night at the sixth leg of the

a week ago. "And my dream is to break 19 seconds in the 200 meters."

Two-time Olympic champion Meseret Defar returned to the track where she set her '07 world 5000 record of 14:16.63 and avenged the defeat handed to her in May by Genzebe Dibaba.

The pacemakers dropped out after 3000

however, and the teenager had to be content with the victory in 8:04.48. Olympic champion Ezekiel Kemboi once again finished behind his younger compatriot, this time with a season's best of 8:07.00.

European champ Vítězslav Veselý was too strong for home favorite Andreas Thorkildsen in the javelin. The Czech led from start to

IAAF Diamond League, stopping the clock in 19.79 to break Frankie Fredericks' meet record of 19.82 set in '96 in beating Michael Johnson. Bolt had come close to that mark when he made his Oslo debut two years ago, running 19.86 in heavy rain.

Norway's Jaysuma Saidy Ndure set a season's best of 20.36 as a far-back runner-up with Britain's James Ellington 3<sup>rd</sup> in 20.55.

"My goals are the same—to be the best in the world and win three gold medals in Moscow," said Bolt, competing for the first time since his defeat to Justin Gatlin in Rome

meters, covered in 8:48.10, and Defar picked up the tempo in an attempt to run the sting out of Dibaba. The tactic worked and she was rewarded with a world-leading time of 14:26.90, her fastest performance since '10, having covered the final lap in 61.7. Kenya's Viola Kibiwot overtook a fading Dibaba to take 2<sup>nd</sup>, 14:33.48–14:37.68.

In the men's steeplechase, world Junior champion Conseslus Kipruto, undefeated this year, was the favourite and was operating close to WR pace for much of the race.

The quick laps eventually took their toll,

finish, opening with 275-6 (83.98) then improving to 282-0 (85.96) in the next round to seal the win. Tero Pitkamaki was runner-up with 278-0 (84.74) as Thorkildsen finished only 6<sup>th</sup> at 265-8 (80.99).

The traditional Dream Mile in Oslo was hit by the withdrawal of World champion Asbel Kiprop, leaving Djibouti's Ayanleh Souleiman to grab his first ever Diamond League win.

Souleiman—a training partner of Olympic 1500 gold medalist Taoufik Makhloufi—hit the front just before the bell and had

enough left down the homestraight to win in 3:50.53. Behind him, Kenya's Nixon Chepseba set a PR of 3:50.95.

The biggest surprise of the night came in the men's discus, where world leader Piotr Malachowski recorded three fouls. 2008 Olympic champion Gerd Kanter held off Olympic silver medallist Ehsan Hadadi to win with 214-11 (65.52).

Reigning world pole vault champion Fabiana Murer similarly made an early exit after three failures at her opening height.

Silke Spiegelburg had a close tussle with Nikolía Kiriakopoulou and eventually gained the advantage by making 15-3 (4.65) in a jumpoff situation after both had identical cards through 15-1 (4.60).

Elsewhere, Anna Chicherova was beaten in the high jump, which was won by fellow Russian Svetlana Shkolina with 6-5½ (1.97), while Olympic finalist Murielle Houré was caught by Ivet Lalova in the 100, 11.04-11.06.

On a night where many of the top US athletes were absent, Arab champion Youssef Masrahi escaped a potential disqualification in the 400 after seemingly jumping the gun and went on to win in 45.33 at the second time of asking.

Winning streaks continued for three women: Zuzana Hejnová in the 400H (season's best 53.60), Christina Schwanitz in the shot (breaking 20 meters for the second time in her career to win with 65-11½ /20.10) and Caterine Ibargüen in the triple jump (leaping 48-7¼/14.81).
