

— USATF Men's Championships —

Des Moines, Iowa, June 20–23—Young and not-so-young. Veterans and rookies. Old and new. Whenever a World Championships team picks itself at a USATF Championships, that's how the team makeup often turns out.

No exceptions this time as the nationals played out at Drake University. But regardless of age, no one stood out like Tyson Gay.

The 30-year-old sprint veteran ran his fastest 100 since '08 and his quickest half-lap in three seasons to write quite the comeback chapter to his notable career.

Of course, the last time Gay tried to double at a nationals/Trials, he went down in a heap some 50 meters into the turn of his '08 Trials 200 heat. He hadn't tried a major meet double since.

But here in the Midwest, Gay put together the pair of 9.75s on the Friday, the final (aided by a 1.1mps wind) to handle main U.S. rival Justin Gatlin (9.89). The veteran duo will be joined in Moscow by NCAA champ Charles Silmon of TCU, who got his first legal sub-10.00 ever at 9.98.

Said Gay, "It feels good to win. It just shows that when you're healthy, it's a level playing field." Gay claimed his fourth U.S. title after three straight wins 2006–08.

He also said after the 100 that he would see how he felt the next day before deciding about running the 200. "Two 9.7s in one day is pretty rough on the body," he added.

He felt good enough the next day to cruise a 20.14 heat. Then on the last day, he clocked a 20.07 (-0.8mps) semi before churning the curve and powering down the backstretch in the title race. As in the 100, the final's racing direction was reversed to take advantage of the strong winds that blew throughout the meet.

The breeze's push registered 1.6mps as Gay's 19.75 pulled Olympian Isiah Young (19.86 PR) and 3rd-placer Curtis Mitchell

(19.99 =PR) to sub-20s as well.

Admitted Gay—who followed up his last nationals dash double with world titles in both in Osaka '07—"Little bit of pride; a little bit of ego. I didn't want to give up on myself. As long as I felt good, I wanted to go for it."

Other veterans to win titles to earn berths to Moscow were the likes of LaShawn Merritt (44.21), Bernard Lagat (14:54.16—really but with a 54.6 final lap), Galen Rupp

winners: George Kitchens (27-0w/8.23), Omar Craddock (56-3¼w/17.15) and the unlooked-for Riley Dolezal (273-11/83.50 to cap a four-consecutive PR javelin series with a Worlds A qualifier on the nose).

All of which led men's head coach Mike Holloway to comment, "This will be an outstanding team with a lot of a mix of youth and veterans. We have a good young team that has stepped up to the plate. We'll be fine with this group."

Then there were the "newer veteran" champions like Duane Solomon (1:43.27), Matthew Centrowitz (3:45.17 off a 51.1 closer), Evan Jager (8:20.67), Michael Tinsley (47.96), Erik Kynard (7-5¾/2.28), Ryan Whiting (72-6 ½/22.11), Lance Brooks (204-4/62.29) and Ashton Eaton (8291).

The USATF Championships also served as the World Championships Trials for Team USA (except for the marathons and 50K walk, which were previously decided).

The first 3 in each event automatically earned team spots for Moscow assuming they had the requisite qualifier, but in many events this was not the case, and the actual team will not be known until after July 20 passes, and the chase-standards period is over.

For now, athletes we believe are “guaranteed” a spot in the team are coded in **brown**, but we could well be wrong. We have made no attempt to ID all those whose situation depends on what happens down the road.

All four days were hot & humid with significant wind. Rain early the last day. Daily highs: 89/31C, 90/32C, 92/33C, 82/28C. Max humidity; 78%, 59%, 79%, 93%.

What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate (“agate” is jounalese for small-type results), so let’s see if we can’t clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as “9, x W” would mean tha the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like “x, 6 A”. The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
