

### — USATF Women's Championships —

Des Moines, Iowa, June 20–23— Three women set four American Records on a sensational Saturday at the USATF Championships, all of them being newcomers to the ranks of AR setters.

First, Michelle Carter powered her fifth put 66-5 (20.24) to raise the shot standard from the 66-2½ (20.18) first set by Ramona Pagel in '88 and matched in '11 by Jill Camarena-Williams, out this year due to a back injury.

“We have been training for a peak at this time of year,” the 27-year-old Carter said of the work with father/coach Michael, himself a former shot great.

“I’ve been working really hard trying to put everything together and get ready for Russia.”

A couple of hours later, Amanda Bingson whirled her second hammer toss out to 245-9 (74.92) to extend the AR from Jessica Cosby-Toruga’s 243-5 (74.19) set last year. Bingson upped her career best from a 239-4 (72.95) she reached in mid-May.

Not finished, she went even farther on her third effort: 248-5 (75.73). “I was a little nervous,” the 23-year-old the UNLV grad said. “I told my coach [Greg Watson] I was really freaking out and he said, ‘Breathe, relax and once you get in the ring, let everything go and trust your body to do what it can do.’ And I did it.”

Then to close the meet’s penultimate

session, NCAA 100H champion Brianna Rollins showed she could run faster with a legal tailwind than she did in wind-assisted prelim races.

In her heat, the 21-year-old from Clemson jad sped 12.33 with a 2.3mps breeze to match the fastest time ever run by an American and

Queen Harrison (12.43) and Nia Ali (12.48) used PRs to close fast and claim 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> while pushing Wells (12.56) and Jones (12.55) to spots 4-5.

“I didn’t think about times or records,” said Rollins. “I just focused on my own lane. I was just so overwhelmed and so

on U.S. soil (Gail Devers’ AR set at the ‘00 Trials).

Then in her semi, Rollins got a 2.8mps boost en route to a 12.30. The stage was set for an explosive final some 3 hours later.

Rollins ended the race and the suspense at the gun, bolting off the line and slicing over the barriers with just 1.2mps of wind at her back as the race was run up the homestretch.

She pulled away from big-name pursuers Kellie Wells and Lolo Jones and flashed across the finish in 12.28 to claim the AR and move to =No. 3 performer all-time with the =No. 4 performance.

There were plenty more stellar performances, starting with English Gardner becoming the first since Carlette ‘91 to win an NCAA-USA 100 double in the same year.

Her PR 10.85 (+1.8mps wind) made the Oregon junior the first since Carlette Guidry of Texas to win both centuries as she pulled Octavious Freeman (10.87) and Alex Anderson (10.91) to PRs in 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Kimberlyn Duncan (21.80w) outran Olympic champ Allyson Felix (21.85w) to

take the half-lap title and hand Felix her first loss in a USATF 200 since she was in high school.

Natasha Hastings ran her fastest 400 in six seasons at 49.94 to win from Francena McCorory's 50.01 PR as Games winner Sanya Richards-Ross couldn't come all the way back from a toe injury as she ran 6<sup>th</sup> (51.92).

Unheralded Dalilah Muhammad slashed her 400H PR by a half-second as her 53.83 edged Olympian Georganne Moline by 0.05. CR setter Kori Carter (illness after the heats) and Worlds defender Lashinda Demus (leg injury) couldn't run.

Brigetta Barrett PRed at 6-8¼ (2.04) to win the high jump and London bronze winner Janay DeLoach Soukup leaped 22-7¼w (6.89) in a tailwind-bedeveled long jump that saw world/Olympic champ Brittney Reese foul three times.

The USATF Championships also served as the World Championships Trials for Team USA (except for the marathons and 50K walk, which were previously decided).

The first 3 in each event automatically earned team spots for Moscow assuming they had the requisite qualifier, but in many events this was not the case, and the actual team will not be known until after July 20 passes, and the chase-standards period is over.

For now, athletes we believe are "guaranteed" a spot in the team are coded in **brown**, but we could well be wrong. We have made no attempt to ID all those whose situation depends on what happens down the road.

All four days were hot & humid with significant wind. Rain early the last day. Daily highs: 89/31C, 90/32C, 92/33C, 82/28C. Max humidity: 78%, 59%, 79%, 93%.

### What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate ("agate" is journalese for small-type results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as "9, x W" would mean that the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
