

— Birmingham DL: Farah Foils Rivals —

Birmingham, England, June 30—A fast time was very much the secondary goal in the 5000 at the Birmingham Diamond League.

The more crucial target for the likes of double Olympic gold medalist Mo Farah, world Junior XC champ Hagos Gebrhiwet and Olympic finalist Yewew Alamirew was to simply win. And in so doing, gain an all-important psychological advantage ahead of the World Championships in August.

Few went with the moderate pace that was being set (5:15.45, 7:59.13). Instead, the race was being dictated from the middle of the

pack by Farah, whose every step was being tracked by Gebrhiwet and Alamirew.

The pace continued to steadily drop as the race went on, but after a spirited injection of pace from Britain's Chris Thompson in the final kilo, the long run for home had finally begun.

Farah, Gebrhiwet and Alamirew kicked hard with a lap to go, almost as though a global gold medal depended on it. With just half a lap left it was still all to play for, and for a moment it looked as though Alamirew was poised to hand Farah a rare defeat on home soil.

But Farah had saved an extra gear for the homestraight and he opened up a gap on Alamirew and the fading Gebrhiwet, crossing the line in 13:14.24.

Alamirew finished 2nd in 13:14.71 with Gebrhiwet further back in 13:17.11. World 10K champ Ibrahim Jeilan was 4th, almost 3 seconds behind his two Ethiopian teammates.

The men's 5 wasn't the only event that gave a glimpse of what to expect in Moscow. Olympic triple jump champion Christian Taylor found that his strongest challenger for gold this year could be world indoor record-

holder Teddy Tamgho.

The Frenchman had a couple of fouls that were close to 18 meters, but managed to record one valid jump at 17.47 (57-3¾).

That mark remained the lead until the penultimate round when Taylor, competing off a full approach for the first time this year, went out to a U.S.-leading 57-11¼ (17.66) to take the win.

World leader Mutaz Essa Barshim withdrew from the high jump with a back injury, but it was still an exciting contest where Ukraine's Bohdan Bondarenko added 3 centimeters to his PR to equal the meet record of 7-8¾ (2.36) to beat Olympic silver medalist Erik Kynard, who equalled his No. 2 jump ever with 7-8 (2.34).

The women's 200 had looked set to be one of the big clashes of the meet as world 100 champion Carmelita Jeter took on two-time Olympic century winner Shelly-Ann Fraser-Pryce. But both were upstaged by Blessing Okagbare, who won in 22.55 as SAFP took 2nd in 22.72, with Jeter—clearly not yet fully recovered from her recent injury—finishing 7th in 23.36.

There were several other surprise defeats too. Reese Hoffa beat Ryan Whiting in the shot, 70-¼ (21.34) to 68-6½ (20.89), and '09 world champ Ryan Brathwaite won the 110 hurdles from WR holder Aries Merritt, 13.13–13.22 (wind 2.6).

Diamond League leaders Amantle Montsho and Vítězslav Veselý were also beaten, Montsho in the 400 by Christine Oheruogu, 50.63–50.64, while Veselý retired from the javelin after just two throws with a tight shoulder, giving Andreas Thorkildsen the win with 275-5 (83.94).

Olympic champions Sally Pearson, Greg Rutherford and Jenn Suhr were all beaten too, as Dawn Harper-Nelson took the hurdles (12.64), Aleksandr Menkov the long jump (27-¾/8.27) and Yarisley Silva the vault (15-6¼/4.73).

Although no world-leading marks were set, Milcah Chemos smashed the meet record in the steeplechase, winning in 9:17.43.

Other winners included Sandra Perkovic in the discus (211-0/64.32 to run her winning streak to 12), Nesta Carter in the 100 (9.99) and Javier Culson in the 400 hurdles (48.59).

What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate (“agate” is jounalese for small-type results), so let’s see if we can’t clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as “9, x W” would mean tha the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like “x, 6 A”. The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
