

— Monaco DL Features Fabulous 1500 —

Fontvieille, Monaco, July 19—Mo Farah broke the European 1500 record as his 3:28.81 chased home former Olympic champ Asbel Kiprop in the IAAF Diamond

League meeting as a near-capacity crowd at the Stade Louis II witnessed 7 world-leading performances overall.

Britain's Olympic 5/10 gold medalist pushed hard all the way to the line which Kiprop had passed in 3:27.72, making the Kenyan the fourth fastest metric mile runner of all time behind Noureddine Morceli, Bernard Lagat and Hicham El Guerrouj.

Kiprop had been effectively launched into a last lap lead as his fellow Kenyan pacer, James Magut, dropped off shortly before the bell, and he had a 20-meter lead over the rest of the field, led by the smaller figure of the Briton, as he came around the final bend.

But Farah closed up in the finishing straight to finish only a few strides adrift of the tall and upright Kenyan, thus breaking not only the ER of 3:28.95 set by Spain's Fermín Cacho in '97, but also the British Record of 3:29.67 set just along the coast in Nice in '85 by Steve Cram—commentating here for BBC-TV.

For Farah, who had been hoping to match or narrowly better the lifetime best of 3:33.98 he had set on this track in '09, it was an astounding result; one which will give his potential rivals in Moscow more to worry about.

Kiprop, meanwhile, was "happy and excited" about

his performance, adding, "I'm very surprised about Mo Farah and his mark of 3:28.81; that's crazy! Now I want to give my best in Moscow."

Farah was a delighted figure afterwards.

"Can you believe that?" he said. "I had a really great session the other day, so I knew I was capable of running 3.30.

"Having had a chat to my coach Alberto [Salazar], I knew that I was capable of running 3.30 on the right day and the right race but, honestly, I didn't think I would run that fast."

Farah thus joined Paavo Nurmi and Sándor Iharos as the only men to hold the Euro 1500 and 10,000 records at the same time.

Brigetta Barrett, who high-jumped 6-7 (2.01) to defeat not only Russia's Olympic champion Anna Chicherova, but also former world champ Blanka Vlašić.

Barrett celebrated victory by performing a well-rehearsed version of *For Once In My Life* before the final fireworks, complete with a group dancing routine.

The U.S. champ went clearance for clearance with Chicherova until the bar got to 6-7. Barrett cleared it first time—cue crazy dancing—but the Russian could not match her, losing to the American for the first time in 5 career meetings.

Local favorite Renaud Lavillenie raised his own outdoor world lead in the vault by a centimeter, scaling 19-6½ (5.96). He now has the 5 highest clearances in the world for the outdoor season.

Amantle Montsho, Botswana's world 400 champion, produced another of the evening's stand-out performances as she won in an NR 49.33, the fastest time in the world this year, a national record and the fastest run ever

in a Diamond League meet.

Behind her, two athletes were towed to PRs: Stephanie McPherson of Jamaica 49.92 and Francena McCorory of the 49.96 to become American member No. 18 of the sub-50 club.

Nigeria's Blessing Okagbare joined the 7-meter club in the long jump, producing a wind-aided 23-1¼ (7.04) in the second round and backing that up with a legal 22-11¾ (7.00) PR in the third.

World leaders also went to Edwin Soi in the 5000 (12:51.34) and Vítězslav Veselý in the javelin 287-8 (87.68).

Jenny Simpson showed her staying power in the 1500 as she won in a U.S.-leading 4:00.48, regaining the lead from Hellen Obiri after the Kenyan runner had forced her way past her as they entered the finishing straight.

Obiri clocked 4:00.93, followed home by three other Americans, Brenda Martinez (4:00.94 PR for No. 10 on the all-time U.S. list), Shannon Rowbury, (season's best 4:01.28) and Gabrielle Anderson (4:01.48 PR).

The men's 1500 wasn't an actual Diamond League event, and neither were the two sprint relays which began the track action with a pair of world-leading times, 37.58 (Charles Silmon, Mike Rodgers, Mookie Salaam, Justin Gatlin) and 41.75 (Octavious Freeman, Allyson Felix, English Gardner, Carmelita Jeter).

U.S. foursomes also finished 2nd in each race, at 38.26 (Jeff Demps, Diondre Batson, Dentarius Locke, Caesio Newman) and 41.78 (Jeneba Tarmoh, Alex Anderson, Barbara Pierre, Auriyall Scott), as the USATF coaching staff worked to name the 6 in each event who will comprise the Moscow relay pool.

You might also find something like "x, 6 A". The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.
