

— Bolt Takes Over London Again —

London, England; July 26–27—He may not have produced one of the meeting's three world-leading marks, but there's little doubt

Moved from its traditional Crystal Palace home in deepest south London to the Olympic Stadium, the 2-day meet was billed as a London 2012 encore; a chance for British fans to make the bowl roar one last time be-

Usain Bolt returned to the scene of his three golds medals 12 months ago.

The giant Jamaican duly gave the 60,000 fans what they'd come to see with a 100 win in 9.85, the quickest dash in the world bar the suspended Tyson Gay's 9.75, meaning Bolt will go to Moscow for the World

Bolt arrived in the Olympic Stadium by rocket; his start could have used one

(reaction 0.175), and such a sluggish pick-up that he was half way down the straight before drawing level with Kim Collins and Mike Rodgers.

Once he got his nose in front after 70m, however, Bolt's giant strides took him home with ground to spare, Rodgers claiming 2nd in 9.98 with Nesta Carter 3rd in 9.99.

With a previous season's best of 9.94, Bolt may have allayed a few of his own fears but he admitted there is much work to do get back to his best before Russia.

"For the first time in a long time I was slightly nervous," he admitted. "I knew it was going to be a big crowd but when I saw the stadium was ram-packed and still like the Olympics, I was like 'Wow!'"

Of the 4 world-leading marks two came in the field, the best by Renaud Lavillenie who racked up his fifth consecutive victory over 19-4¼ (5.90) and topped it off by clearing 19-9 (6.02) with one clean attempt, the best outdoor vault since Brad Walker's U.S. Record 19-9¾ (6.04) in '08.

It budged the Frenchman up to No. 7 all-time outdoors, and he had a good crack at going No. 1 with three shots at 20-2½ (6.16).

Valerie Adams "closed a chapter" on the bitter disappointment of the Olympic shot put final when she was beaten by Nadzeya Ostapchuk in this stadium only to be belatedly handed gold when the Belarusian failed a drugs test.

The New Zealander, who feels robbed of her golden moment, produced six throws all beyond 20 meters (65-7½), the longest of 68-7 (20.90) eclipsing her own world lead by three-quarters of an inch for a meet record.

Zuzana Hejnová chalked up her ninth straight 400m hurdles victory of the season with an impressive win over Britain's Perri Shakes-Drayton and NCAA champion Kori Carter in a Czech Record 53.07.

Carter, in her first final in 7 weeks, could only finish 4th and lost her world lead into the bargain as Georganne Moline took 3rd in 54.32. Shakes-Drayton PRed in 2nd with 53.67.

There was better success for U.S. women in the distance races, not least for Shannon Rowbury who ran away from fellow-Americans Gabriele Anderson and Molly Huddle to win the 3000 in a U.S.-leading 8:41.46, a great incentive she said to "run like hell" in the Moscow 5000.

Jamaica's double Olympic champion Shelly-Ann Fraser-Pryce clocked a world-leading 10.77 in the 100 heats then could

only finish 4th in the final when Nigeria's Blessing Okagbare clocked her second African record of the day to win in 10.79.

Fraser-Pryce ran 10.94 in the final while world champion Carmelita Jeter scratched with tightness in her quadriceps after clocking a season's best 10.93 in the heat.

The unstoppable Ukrainian Bohdan Bondarenko won another cat and mouse duel with US Olympic silver medallist Erik Kynard, clearing 7-9¾ (2.38) before making two audacious attempts at 8-1¼ (2.47), 2 centimeters above Javier Sotomayor's World Record, just a day short of 20 years since the Cuban's great leap upwards.

"I feel I will get it in Moscow," said Bondarenko.

What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate (“agate” is jounalese for small-type results), so let’s see if we can’t clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as “9, x W” would mean tha the person had moved to No. 9 on the all-time world list, with a performance outside the top 10. Had it say, been the No. 9 performance, the notation would have been 9, 9 W.

You might also find something like “x, 6 A”. The x in the first position means the mark is not a PR, but the performance is No. 6 in U.S. history.

We note all-time list positions for World (W), U.S. (A), College (C), Juniors (WJ or AJ) and High School (HS).

We also denote yearly list leaders for the World (WL), U.S. (AL), College (CL; Division I only) and High School (HS).
