

### — Stockholm DL: Post-WC Action Begins —

Stockholm, Sweden, August 22—Maybe it was the accumulation of three demanding seasons that featured the '11 Worlds, '12 Olympics and '13 Worlds.

Perhaps it was just the fact that this year's DN Galan was the first Diamond League meet following Moscow and many athletes hadn't regained full sharpness for the remaining push to the end of the campaign.

Or maybe it was just the crisp conditions on a sometimes-breezy Scandinavian evening.

But whatever the reason(s), the 47<sup>th</sup> annual affair in the storied red brick 1912 Olympic Stadium never quite produced the fire that might be expected of a meet featuring a dozen newly-crowned global victors.

Still, the final four events on the schedule provided some entertaining competition, including the evening's best effort.

In the gathering chill, Moscow 5K champion Meseret Defar led the 3000 at the 2K mark (5:47.06) as well as at the bell. Her 61-second final lap then closed a 2:43.23 final kilo that secured her outdoor world-leading 8:30.29 victory.

"To be able to come here and win just a few days after the World Championships is good," said Defar. "I'm so happy for this victory.

"I ran 14:50 in [the Moscow 5000], which is

not fast for me. So I was able to run well tonight. I am in good shape."

Defar outran Worlds rival Mercy Chero-

no, whose PR 8:31.23 led home career-best efforts by Sifan Hassan 8:32.53 (3<sup>rd</sup>), Viola Kibiwott 8:33.97 (4<sup>th</sup>) and Gladys Cheron 8:34.05 (5<sup>th</sup>).

Shannon Rowbury finished 7<sup>th</sup> in a U.S.-leading 8:34.43, her second-fastest 3000 ever.

"Still a little tired from those 5Ks at Worlds but still ran a season's best and was only 3 sec off my PR," she tweeted.

The race before Defar's saw 110H champ David Oliver thoroughly dominate a good field. His 13.21 easily bested Moscow bronze winner Sergey Shubenkov (13.35) with Jason Richardson (13.37) 4<sup>th</sup>.

But Worlds silver medalist Ryan Wilson whacked a lot of barriers and was held to 6<sup>th</sup> in 13.60.

Next up, 400 champ LaShawn Merritt had no problems handling a field absent arch-rival Kirani James, his 44.69 giving him a comfortable win ahead of Luegelín Santos (45.25) and Pavel Maslák (45.33).

The meet's concluding race saw world champ 800 Eunice Sum clock 1:58.84 to win ahead of the 1:58.96 by American Alysia Montañó—who finished in lane 5.

As the bunched field came off the final turn, Montañó and Ajee' Wilson appeared to bump and Montañó veered to the outside and kept drifting out until she finished in the middle of the

Wilson (1:59.96 for the No. 4 American Junior performance ever) ended up 4<sup>th</sup> but ahead of world 1500 champ Abeba Aregawi (6<sup>th</sup> in 2:01.22) and 800 bronze winner Brenda Martinez (7<sup>th</sup> in 2:01.54).

Other Moscow winners to emerge victorious in the Swedish capital included Zuzana Hejnová (53.70), Valerie Adams (66-7/4/20.30—both earning 1-carat diamonds for stadium records and Adams earning her 40<sup>th</sup> straight win), Aleksandr Menkov (26-10/ 8.18), Svetlana Shkolina (6-6/1.98) and Catherine Ibargüen (47-11¼/14.61).

But other champions and notables bit the dust. 1500 winner Asbel Kiprop placed only 6<sup>th</sup> (3:35.49) as early leader Ayanleh Souleiman (3:35.29) held off Silas Kiplagat (3:35.92).

Steeple champion Ezekiel Kemboi dropped out with more than two laps left and later was helped from the stadium by medical personnel with both ankles taped, the left heavily so. Hillary Yego clocked a winning 8:09.81 ahead of Gilbert Kirui (8:11.55).

Javelin champ Christina Obergföll reached only 204-7 (62.36) for 3<sup>rd</sup> behind German teammate Linda Stahl (209-2/63.75) and Russia's Mariya Abakumova, whose 225-0 (68.59) earned her the meet record win and her own diamond.

Obergföll's loss shot down her chances at becoming only the second athlete (after Blanka Vlašić in the '10 high jump) to go 7-for-7 in DL competition.

Hejnová kept her chances of so doing alive with her win, and discus thrower Sandra Perković—whose event wasn't part of the proceedings here—already has her 6 wins. (Adams is undefeated this year, but skipped the Shanghai and Oslo shots, so is only 4-for-4).
