

— NYC Marathons To Mutai & Jeptoo —

New York City, November 3—A year after Superstorm Sandy washed out the race, the New York City Marathon returned in fine form as Geoffrey Mutai produced another

zuneish Deba and her training partner Tigist Demisse immediately broke clear of the field. Undaunted by headwinds, the Ethiopian duo cruised through their adopted hometown splitting 34:44 for the opening 10K, a whop-

Cognizant of the burgeoning gap, Jeptoo went to work and after 15 miles set off in solo pursuit. "I didn't get another person to run with me after leaving the group," the 29-year-old Kenyan said, "but I realized that

dominating victory and Priscah Jeptoo rallied from a huge deficit.

While the weather didn't wipe out this year's race, blustery winds and cool temperatures eschewed prospects for fast running as Mutai clocked 2:08:25, well clear of Tsegaye Kebede, whose 2:09:16 locked down the 2012-13 WMM men's title and the \$500,000 prize that goes with it.

The women's field set off first across the Verrazano Bridge and '11 runner-up Bu-

ping 2:11 ahead of a ever-cautious chase pack.

Deba, who two years ago chased down Mary Keitany after an equally brash start, was fully committed to the fast start, explaining, "That was our plan; we train together and we are both strong, so we run that pace but no one follows."

Indeed they probably wondered if anyone else was in the race as their lead grew to 3:22 when they passed halfway in 72:38.

three minutes is almost one kilometer. So I pushed alone."

While Jeptoo upped her tempo, Demisse fell off Deba's pace at 19 miles, and by 22 miles Jeptoo closed within 38 seconds as Deba's stomach started to cramp. Just before 24 miles, Jeptoo's chase ended as she sailed past her struggling rival and sailed to a 2:25:07 victory, 49 seconds ahead of Deba.

WMM prize-winner Jeptoo, who in April had won the London Marathon, closed the

second half in 69:07, and was confident in her form, admitting, "I had to persevere because I knew that I had trained a lot and nothing to fear. This is a great moment for me, and this is a day I will not forget for the rest of my life."

The men's race took on a different character as a lead pack of 20 bunched together through a 65:06 opening half. Descending the Queensboro Bridge, Kebede pushed the pace as Stephen Kiprotich, his rival for the WMM title dinged his back on the off-ramp.

"I come to New York, because I want to win this competition," Kebede offered. "I wanted just to push and everybody follows me until I was at 20 miles, and I was getting a calf problem."

At that point as the course turned south and the headwind became a tailwind over the final 10K, Mutai made his move. Much like the '11 race—when he lowered the course record to a stellar 2:05:06—the 32 year-old Kenyan began a long sustained drive to the finish.

"When I decided to go, I was feeling OK, and the wind was not there," he said. "When I made my move, I feel comfortable and I don't look back. I'm only going to my way."

The winner strung together 4:44, 4:40 and 4:39 miles to break the race open and cruised to a well-earned victory.

To win on this course and to repeat again, it's not easy," he said. "This was the toughest marathon I have ever run, with the cold and wind I was never comfortable so it was a big challenge."

Kebede managed to calm his cramping calf by pouring water on it and moved up to second over the final miles to secure the coveted WMM prize.
