The Finish Judges farther along in the chute did not put the men back into their correct finish order so, as a result, the runners in 37th, 38th, and 39th positions were mis-placed on the original report of the race. Movies of the race revealed the error, and the placings on this revised report restore correct finishes. Insofar as team scores are concerned, these corrections change the team totals of the three teams involved but in no way alter team standings as published originally.
