

A HISTORY OF THE NCAA WOMEN'S OUTDOOR TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS 1982–2018

This compilation does not attempt to reproduce the complete results of the NCAA Women's Championships.

While the team-scoring section does include all teams which accumulated points, for the actual events the results are only given 8-deep (the depth of modern point-scoring).

Marks made in preliminaries are included only if they had some sort of record significance.

Unlike the professional side of the sport, where names are changed to reflect the last one under which the athlete competed, in this compilation women are switched to their married names only if they did so while in actual collegiate competition.

TEAM SCORING

Three different scoring systems have been used through the years:

1982—12 places (15-12-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1); places 9–12 in lane races came from “consolation finals” which were for the 4 lowest spots

1983 & '84—same 12-place scoring as in '82, but there were no consolation finals; lower places in lane races based on time from the semis

1985 through today—8 places (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1)
