

2019 World Championships Statistics - Women's 100mH

The records to look for in Doha:

- 1) Can Harrison become only the second WR holder to win the World Championships at 100mH?
Zargocheva who set WR on Aug 8, 1987 and won the WC a month later is the only one so far.
- 2) Can Harrison break the championships record of 12.28 by Sally Pearson?
- 3) Can she also win with the larger margin than Pearson did (0.19 seconds) in 2011?
- 4) Can Danielle Williams become fifth multiple champion?
